

An ACT continuing an Act, entitled, *An Act for the Gauge of Barrels of Pork, Beef, Pitch, Tar, Turpentine, and Tare of Barrels of Flour or Bread.*

An Act for the Gauge of Barrels of Pork, &c. continued.

**B**E it enacted, by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, by and with the Advice and Consent of his Governor, and the Upper and Lower Houses of Assembly, and the Authority of the same, That an Act of Assembly of this Province, entitled, *An Act for the Gauge of Barrels of Pork, Beef, Pitch, Tar, Turpentine, and Tare of Barrels of Flour or Bread*, made at a Session of Assembly, begun and held at the City of Annapolis, the Fifth Day of August, One Thousand Seven Hundred and Forty-five, be and is hereby continued, and shall remain and be in full Force, for and during the Term of Seven Years, and to the End of the next Session of Assembly which shall happen after the End of the said Seven Years.

## C H A P. XVI.

An ACT continuing an Act, entitled, *An Act to establish a Market in Frederick-Town in Frederick County, and for the Regulation of the said Market.*

An Act to establish a Market in Frederick-Town continued.

**B**E it enacted, by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, by and with the Advice and Consent of his Governor, and the Upper and Lower Houses of Assembly, and the Authority of the same, That an Act of Assembly of this Province, entitled, *An Act to establish a Market in Frederick-Town, in Frederick County, and for the Regulation of the said Market*, made at a Session of Assembly, begun and held at the City of Annapolis, the Sixth Day of November, One Thousand Seven Hundred and Seventy, be and is hereby continued, and shall be and remain in full Force, for and during the full Term of Seven Years, and to the End of the next Session of Assembly which shall happen after the End of the said Seven Years.

## C H A P. XVII.

**B**E it enacted, by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, by and with the Advice and Consent of his Governor, and the Upper and Lower Houses of Assembly, and the Authority of the same, That an Act of Assembly of this Province, entitled, *An Act for relieving the Inhabitants of this Province from some Aggrievances in the Prosecution of Suits at Law*, made at a Session of Assembly, begun and held at the City of Annapolis, the Twenty-second Day of June, One Thousand Seven Hundred and Fourteen, and the Supplementary Act thereto, made at a Session of Assembly, begun and held at the City of Annapolis, the Third Day of October, One Thousand Seven Hundred and Twenty-eight, be and are hereby continued, and shall remain and be in full Force, for and during the Term of Twenty-one Years, and to the End of the next Session
