VII. and be it further enafted, That every Person, by this Act ap- Penalty on pointed as a Trustee for the Poor, or that shall hereaster be nominated resuling to and appointed as such, pursuant to the Directions hereof, and who shall wilfully refuse or delay to take upon him the said Office, shall forfeit and pay, for every such Resusal or Delay, the Sum of Ten Pounds Current Money: Provided, That no Member of the Upper or Lower House of Proviso, Assembly, Clergyman, Attorney, or practising Physician; be obliged to accept of the Office of Trustee aforesaid, or forfeit, as aforesaid, for refusing to accept and take upon him the same: And that no Provincial or County Magistrate, or Sheriff, or any one who hath not the Qualification to be a Member of the Lower House of Assembly, if elected, shall be capable to be chosen, or act as a Trustee aforesaid; nor shall any Person be compellable to serve, in less than Three Years after he hath ferved or paid the said Forfeiture, for not serving as a Trustee aforesaid.

VIII. And, For enabling the said Trustees to purchase Land and erect Trustees to an Alms and Work-House in the said County, Be it enacted, That the draw on the Sheriff for as said Trustees, or the major Part of them, be, and they are hereby au-much Tothorized and impowered, from Time to Time, as Occasion shall require, bacco as they shall think to draw upon the Sheriff of Saint Mary's County, in whose Hands the necessary, for Tobacco aforesaid, so as aforesaid to be affessed and levied, or such Part the Uses di-1 thereof as shall, by Virtue of this Act, be so assessed and levied, shall re- Act. main, for so much of the said Tobacco as the said Trustees, or the major Part of them, shall from Time to Time think it necessary to draw, for the Uses and Purposes directed by this Act,

IX. And be it surther enasted, That the said Trustees, or the major Trustees to Part of them, appointed as aforesaid, shall, and they are hereby au-Landto build thorized, directed, and required, to buy and purchase, in Fee, a Quan-an Alms and tity of Land in the said County, not exceeding One Hundred Acres; House; and the said Trustees, or the major Part of them, appointed as aforesaid, are hereby authorized, directed, and required, to agree and contract with a Workman or Workmen, to undertake, erect, build, and in a Workmanlike Manner to complete and finish, on the said Land, when so purchased, good, strong, sufficient, and convenient Houses, Habitations, and Dwellings, for the Reception of the Poor of said County, and of such Vagrants, Beggars, Vagabonds, and other Offenders, as shall be committed by yirtue of this Act; and they shall appropriate one Part thereof, to be called the Alms-House, to and for the Reception and Lodging of the Poor of the faid Sounty, and another Part or Parts thereof, to be called the Work-House, to and for the Reception and Lodging of all such Vagrants, Beggars, Vagabonds, and other Offenders, as shall be committed by virtue of this Act; and the ascresaid Land, when bought, and the aforesaid Houses, Habitations, and Dwellings, when built, shall be, and they are hereby enacted and declared to be, vested in the said Trustees, as their Estate and Inheritance; for the Uses and Purposes by this Act directed and expressed.
