

offending, shall forfeit and pay the Sum of Ten Pounds, to be recovered C H A P. XXIV. XXV. XXVI. and applied as before directed.

VIII. And be it further enacted, That nothing herein contained shall extend, or be construed to extend, to prevent any Person or Persons whatsoever from killing Deer within their actual Inclosures, or Islands, or in that Part of *Frederick* County lying to the Westward of the North Mountain. Persons may kill Deer within their Inclosures, &c.

IX. This Act to continue for and during the Term of Twelve Years, and until the End of the next Session of Assembly which shall happen after the said Twelve Years. Continuance.

C H A P. XXV.

An ACT for the Repair of the Paper Currency Office.

WHEREAS it is represented to this General Assembly, That the said Office is in want of immediate Repair, Preamble.

II. Be it enacted, by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, by and with the Advice and Consent of his Governor, and the Upper and Lower Houses of Assembly, and the Authority of the same, That the Commissioners for emitting Bills of Credit shall, and they are hereby empowered and required, as soon as conveniently may be, to agree with proper Workmen to repair the said Office, in such Manner and Form as to them shall seem proper, and shall and may pay the Expence thereof out of the Interest arising from the Loan of Bills of Credit emitted by Virtue of the Act, entitled, *An Act for emitting Bills of Credit, and other Purposes therein mentioned.* Commissioners for emitting Bills of Credit to agree with Workmen to repair the Paper Currency Office, &c.

C H A P. XXVI.

An ACT for emitting Bills of Credit, and applying Part thereof.

WHEREAS an Emission of Bills of Credit is, at this Time of general Scarcity of Specie, thought expedient for carrying on the Trade and Commerce of this Province, and for answering divers other beneficial public Purposes; Preamble.

II. Be it therefore enacted, by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, by and with the Advice and Consent of his Governor, and the Upper and Lower Houses of Assembly, and the Authority of the same, That Bills of Credit, of the Denomination of Dollars and Parts of a Dollar, to the Amount of Four Hundred and Eighty Thousand Dollars, that is to say, Two Hundred and Sixty-six Thousand Six Hundred and Sixty-six Dollars, and Two Third Parts of a Dollar for Loan, Eighty Thousand Dollars for the Purposes herein after particularly mentioned, and for such other Purposes as shall hereafter be appointed by Act of the General Assembly, and One Hundred and Thirty-three Thousand Three Hundred and Thirty-three Dollars and One Third Part of a Dollar, for the Purpose of exchanging such of the said Bills as shall be emitted in virtue of this Act, and which shall become torn, defaced, and unfit to pass, shall be printed and struck with all convenient Speed, on good single Paper, under the Care and Direction of the Commissioners appointed, or to be appointed, by virtue of an Act, entitled, *An Act for emitting Bills of Credit,* Bills of Credit to be printed under Direction of the Commissioners.
