Be it also enacted, That the Printer of the said Bills shall not, by One or both himself, Servants, or any other Person by him employed, presume to stoners to atprint, stamp, stitch, or bind, the said Bills, or any of them, but in the tend the Presence of one or both of the said Commissioners, who are hereby re- Press, &c. quired and directed to be present; and at all Times when there shall be any Intermission of the said Work of Printing or Binding, the said Commissioners shall safely and securely lock up the Press, Stamps, and Flowers, with which the said Work shall be performed, and the Impressions that shall be then made, in the Room in which the Printing and Binding aforesaid shall be done, and the Keys of such Room shall keep in their Possession: And when all the said Bills shall be printed and The Stamps stamped, the Stamps and Flowers, by which such Impressions shall be and Flowers to be delivermade, shall be delivered by the Printer to the said Commissioners, under ed to the the Penalty of Five Hundred Pounds Current Money, to be recovered Commissional as aforefaid. And the faid Commissioners are barely directed and reserve and deas aforesaid. V. And be it further enacted, That any Person or Persons, who shall Personscounforge or counterfeit any of the said Bills of Credit, or alter the Sum exterseiting
