

An ACT for Payment of the public Creditors.

Commissioners for emitting Bills of Credit to pay the public Creditors their Allowance on the Journal of Accounts, as soon as a sufficient Number of Bills shall be printed and signed.

BE it enacted, by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, by and with the Advice and Consent of his Governor, and the Upper and Lower Houses of Assembly, and the Authority of the same, That as soon as a sufficient Number of the Bills of Credit, to be emitted by virtue of the Act, entitled, *An Act for emitting Bills of Credit, and applying Part thereof*, shall be printed, numbered, and signed, the Commissioners for emitting Bills of Credit shall, and they are hereby authorized and required to deliver, out of the Eighty Thousand Dollars to be emitted by virtue of the said Act, for the Purposes therein particularly mentioned, and for such other Purposes as should be appointed by Act of the General Assembly, to the several Persons, their Executors, Administrators, Assigns, or Orders, who are allowed by the Public, or to such of them as shall offer to receive the same, the Value, according to the Rate of One Dollar and Two Third Parts of a Dollar for every Hundred Pounds of Tobacco, and according to the Rate of One Dollar for every Seven Shillings and Six-pence in Money, allowed to them respectively, as they appear to be allowed, stated, and ascertained, by the Journal of Accounts assented to this present Session by both Houses of Assembly.
