That it shall and may be bedischarged lawful for the several and respective Inhabitants of the Parish aforesaid, in Money. to pay and discharge the said several Quantities of Tobacco, so to be levied and raised for the Uses aforesaid, in Money, in the same Manneras they are or shall hereafter be enabled to pay and discharge the Public or County Levies, any Clause, Matter, or Thing, herein to the contrary notwith-Itanding.
