Parish aforesaid for the Time Being; one othersfor the Ahmehwardens of Call Air. the faid Parish for the Time being, and Two hother Pews income cont venient Part of the Church for the Jurymen, who halk from Timento Time attend the Provincial Court, And, Lasternithe faid Reve shall he affigned as aforefaid, and after Four Weeks Notice in the Manyland Gazette of a particular and convenient Dayifor the Subscribers to choose their Pews, the said Subscribers shall be admitted to choose each a Rewi in the faid Church, the Subscriber of the greatest Sum of Money having the First Choice, and so of the Rest. each being preserved in the Choice according to the Sum of his or her Subscription; but if divers Persons shall have subscribed like Sums, then the Priority of Choice shall be determined by Lot, and if any Subscriber shall not be present, or refuse to choose in Turn, the Trustees aforesaid, or the major Part of them, may choose for him or her, of which said Choices Entries shall be made in the Register Book of the said Parish, and the said Pews shall be to the said Subscribers respectively in Fee Simple.

VII. Provided always, That no Subscriber, as such, shall be entered the to a Pew, unless his or her Subscriber have, any Preserence in Choice entitled to a unless his or her Subscriber have, any Preserence in Choice entitled to a unless his or her Subscription shall be made at one and the same Time here, we tire, and shall exceed the Subscription of the other Subscribers, of whom he or she claims a Preserence, Five Pounds at the least.

VIII. Provided allo, and be it enacted, That no Perion what dever Provide shall at one and the same Time, in any Manner; hold of have more than one Pew in the said Church.

IX. And be it enaited. That after the Subscribers shall have their Trustees to Pews as aforesaid, the Trustees aforesaid, or the major Part of them, expose to sale shall set up and expose to sale; to the said Parishioners of the said Parish of the Pews. and none others, the Residue of the Pews in the said Church; and the said Trustees shall allow to such Purchaser the Amount of his Taxables in the Purchase Money; and shall apply all Money arising from such Sales in and for the Purposes aforesaid, the said Trustees taking care that there be Twenty Pews at least for Sale as aforesaid.

X. And be it enaited. That there shall be lover and above the Pows A Gallery to aforesaid, a common Gallery or Place for any of the Parishippers, who be erected, may occasionally come to the faid Church, nandialous some convenient. Place settapart for Servants, and another some Slaves, that may attend Divine Service.

C H A P. XII.

A Supplement to the Act to unite the Free Schools of Somerand Wordester Counties.

HEREAS it is represented to this present General Assembly, by preamble, the Visitors of Edin School in Somerset County, that they have purchased Lands, erected Buildings, and procured Masters, for said School, but have sound it, by Experience, extremely difficult to procure a Majority of said Visitors to transact the Business of said School, either at their stated or occasional Meetings, and praying that an Act might pass, enabling any Seven of the Visitors of said School to transact any Business relative thereto;
