to them. And if the said Commissioners shall not meet and sit as aforesaid, the Commissioners sailing therein shall forseit and pay the Sum of two hundred Pounds current Money, unless prevented by Sickness or other unavoidable Accident. And if any Person, whose Property shall be assessed and rated in Virtue of this Act, shall apprehend himself thereby injured or grieved, and shall thereof complain to the said Commissioners, the faid Commissioners shall and may, at the Time of their fitting to hear Appeals as aforesaid, particularly examine any Person or Persons (other than the Party complaining) upon his or their Oath, touching the Value of such real or personal Property (except in the Case of ready Money, in which Case the Party's own Oath shall be admitted) and upon due Examination or Knowledge thereof, abate, increale, or enlarge, the said Assessment and Rate, and a Copy of the same, so abated, increased, or enlarged, shall forthwith deliver, or cause to be delivered, to the Collector of their respective Counties, who shall collect and levy the same, as herein directed.

XXVI. and he it enacted, That the Clerks of the several County County Clerks to Courts within this State shall, for a reasonable Reward to be made make out them by the Justices of their County in the County Levy, make out Lists of Taxand deliver to the Commissioners of their respective Counties, on or be-ables, &c. fore the twentieth Day of May next, and annually during the Continuance of this Act, fair and exact Copies of the last List of Taxables, returned by the Constables of the several Hundreds within their said Counties, on Pain of forfeiting fifty Pounds current Money; and the said Commidioners shall deliver the said Lists to the respective Assesfors, at the Time of their Qualification; under the like Penalty for each Neglect or Omission thereof.

XXVII. And be it enaued, That the said Commissioners shall deli- Commissioners to deliver ver to the Sheriffs of their respective Counties, who are hereby ap- to Sheriffs pointed Collectors of the Assessment and Pound Rate aforesaid, a fair Certificates Copy of the Certificates of Assessment delivered to them by the Assessment, fors as aforesaid, on or before the twentieth Day of August next, and on or before the same Day annually during the Continuance of this Act, under the Penalty of two hundred Pounds current Money for each Commissioner.

XXVIII. And be it enacted, That the respective Collectors may and Collectors hall, at any Time after the tenth Day of September next, and after the may collect the Pound same Day annually, during the Continuance of this Act, collect the Rate by Dissaid Pound Rate by Distress and Sale of any Goods or Chattels within tress, &c. his County, the Property of any Person assessed, of which Sale five Days Notice, excluding the Day of Notice and Sale, shall be given, and by Distress and Sale of any Goods or Chattels found on the Land of any Person assessed, of which the same Notice shall be given, and if no Effects can be found on the Land, the Owner thereof shall be liable for the Pound Rate so assessed, and the Land shall be chargeable for the Payment thereof, with fix per Cent. Interest thereon, in the Hands of any Purchaser, and any Goods at any Time found on the Premises shall be liable to Distress and Sale for the Payment thereof; and the respective Collectors shall annually pay the whole Amount of the Assessment and Pound Rate on all the real and personal Property within his County, after deducting thereout the Suins by this Act allowed
