

of such Receipt by the Collector, on the Balance; and in the same Manner shall he be credited by the Collector and paid Interest on the Balance for any Number of Years thereafter, according to the Sum of Money advanced as aforesaid.

XXI

XL. And be it enacted, That Mr. *Frederick Green*, Printer, according to his Agreement with the House of Delegates, shall print and stich in blue Paper Covers five hundred and fifty Copies of this Act, and make up into eighteen Parcels of twenty-five Copies each, directed to the Commissioners named in this Act, for the several Counties; and each Commissioner shall keep one of the said Copies for his own Use, and the others shall by the said Commissioners be distributed to the Assessors that shall be appointed for the several Hundreds in their respective Counties; which Parcels the said Printer shall indorse for the public Service, and deliver to the Sheriff of *Anna Arundel* County, on or before the fifth Day of *May* next; under the Penalty of one hundred Pounds current Money; and the several Sheriffs are hereby required to forward them in the same Manner as public Letters; and the Printer shall deliver the Residue of said Copies to the Clerks of the Senate and House of Delegates.

XLI. And, Whereas it may be necessary to make Provision for Intelligence, Expresses, and other Contingencies, which is impossible particularly to express and specify in this Act;

XLII. Be it enacted, That it shall and may be lawful to and for the Governor of this State for the Time being, from Time to Time, during the Continuance of this Act, to draw his Order or Orders on either of the Treasurers aforesaid, for the Purposes aforesaid, for any Sum or Sums of Money not exceeding in the Whole the Sum of two hundred Pounds current Money, payable to such Person or Persons as he shall think fit; and the said Treasurers are hereby directed and required to pay all such Orders so as aforesaid drawn, the Governor expressing in such Order the particular Use or Purpose for which the same is or shall be drawn.

Governor may draw on the Treasurer, &c.

XLIII. And be it enacted, That the several Commissioners, Assessors, and Collectors, appointed in this Act, and to be appointed yearly for two Years, in Virtue thereof, shall yearly, according to the Directions of this Act, do and perform the several Services and Duties required of them on or by the respective Times herein mentioned for doing and performing the same for the first Year; and under the like Pains, Penalties, and Forfeitures.

Commissioners, &c. to perform their several Duties yearly.

XLIV. And be it enacted, That out of the Money to be collected in Virtue of this Act, so much thereof as may be necessary, shall be applied towards the Payment of the Quota of the Interest due from this State on the Monies borrowed by Congress to defray the Expenses of the War, and the Residue thereof shall be applied towards sinking Part of the Bills of Credit emitted by this State.

How the Money collected is to be applied.

XLV. And be it enacted, That the Collectors in the several Counties, or some one of their Deputies, shall annually between the first and tenth Day of *September*, attend at some convenient Place (as near
