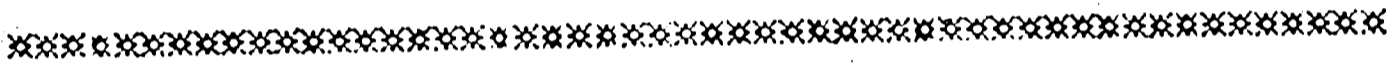


which they may think proper; and to make such Exports from this State which they may judge necessary. And the Governor and the Council are also authorised and empowered to employ such Person or Persons to fit, equip, and manage the Vessels of War belonging to this State, and to do any other Business, under the Controul and Superintendance of the Governor and Council, which they may think fit. And the Governor and the Council may draw on either of the Treasurers for such Sums of Money as they may think necessary, for the Purposes aforesaid, and to carry into Execution the Powers invested in them by this Act. And in Case of the Absence of the Governor, the Council may execute all the Power and Authority by this Act invested in the Governor and the Council.

VI. And be it enacted, That the Resolves of this Session be and are hereby declared to be equally binding with the Acts of the General Assembly.
