An ACT to revive the proceedings of Saint Mary's county

Preamble.

HEREAS the actions, process and proceedings, depending and undetermined in Saint Mary's county March adjourned court, were discontinued for want of magistrates to attend the faid court,

Actions undetermined to be in the fame state next county court, as if the discontinuance had never happened, &c.

II. Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Mayland, That all actions, process and proceedings, as well civil as criminal, which were depending and undetermined in the faid Saint Mary's county March adjourned court, shall be construed, judged and taken, to be in the same lituation, state and condition, at the next county court to be held for the said county, as they would have been had the said discontinuance never happened; and the justices of the said county may then proceed to the hearing and determining the said actions, process and proceedings, respectively, as the case may require, as fully and effectually as the justices of the said court could or might lawfully have done had the said discontinuance never happened.
