C H A P. V, VI, VII. shall proceed to collect and levy the same in manner before directed.

In case of persons having paid the assessment, &c.

VIII. And be it enacted, That in case it shall appear to the sheriff, that the persons assessed, in the district of any deceased collector, have paid their assessments to such collector, then the sheriff shall call upon the executor or administrator of such collector, and demand the money by him received, and enforce payment thereof in the manner prescribed by this act.

Non-enrollers may be committed to gaol, &c.

IX. And be it enacted, That if any non-enroller, neglecting or refusing as aforesaid, shall not have sufficient goods or effects to discharge such fine and the costs arising on distress of such goods and effects, the sheriff may take the body of such non-enroller, and commit him to the gaol of the county where the defaulter may reside, until payment of the fine and all costs and charges.

C H A P. VI.

An ACT to revive the proceedings of Saint Mary's county court.

Preamble.

WHEREAS the actions, process and proceedings, depending and undetermined in Saint Mary's county March adjourned court, were discontinued for want of magistrates to attend the said court,

Actions undetermined to be in the same state next county court as if the discontinuance had never happened, &c.

II. Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That all actions, process and proceedings, as well civil as criminal, which were depending and undetermined in the said Saint Mary's county March adjourned court, shall be construed, judged and taken, to be in the same situation, state and condition, at the next county court to be held for the said county, as they would have been had the said discontinuance never happened; and the justices of the said county may then proceed to the hearing and determining the said actions, process and proceedings, respectively, as the case may require, as fully and effectually as the justices of the said court could or might lawfully have done had the said discontinuance never happened.

C H A P. VII.

An ACT to continue an act for enlarging the powers of the governor and the council.

An act continued.

BE it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That an act passed at a session of assembly begun and held at the city of Annapolis, the fifth day of February, seventeen hundred and seventy seven, entitled, An act for enlarging the powers of the governor and the council, be and is hereby continued, and shall remain and be in full force until the fifth day of the next session of the general assembly.
