C H A P. XVIII.

An ACT for the payment of the journal of accounts.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it appears by the journal of accounts and list of debts, that there is now due from this state the sum of seventeen hundred and sixty-two pounds seventeen shillings and seven-pence common money,

Treasurer of western shore to pay the journal of accounts.

II. Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the treasurer of the western shore shall and is hereby authorized and required, to deliver out of the bills of credit which now are or shall be in his hands for the use of this state, to the several persons, their executors, administrators, assigns or orders, who are allowed on the said journal, or to such of them as shall offer to receive the same, the several sums of money allowed to them respectively, as they appear to be allowed, stated, and ascertained by the journal of accounts and list of debts aforesaid.
