III. And be it enacted, That the money shall be paid immediately on the service done, and the registers in chancery and court of admiralty respectively shall, every half year, pay the same to the treasurer of the western shore, for the use of the public, and shall annually lay before the general assembly a fair account of their receipts, and shall be allowed a commission of two and an half per cent. in full for their trouble and service in the execution of this act.

IV. This act to continue until the first day of November next, and until the end of the next session of assembly which shall happen thereafter.
