And he it enafted, That the money shall be paid immediately Money to be paid on seron the service done, and the registers in chancery and court of admi-vicedone, &c. ralty respectively shall, every half year, pay the same to the treasurer of the western shore, for the use of the public, and shall annually lay before the general assembly a fair account of their receipts, and shall be allowed a commission of two and an half per cent. in full for their trouble and service in the execution of this act.
