An ACT to prevent and suppress insurrections.

HEREAS there have been frequent insurrections and out- Preamble. rages committed in Somerset county, and in some other counties, by the disaffected inhabitants,

Be it enauen, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Governor and governor and the council are hereby empowered and requested to cause cause the mithe militia of Somerset and Caroline counties, and of any other county feeted counthey may have good reason to believe are disaffected, to be called out ties to be callotherwise than by classes as directed by an act, entitled, An act to regulate the militia, in such manner as to them may appear most for the advantage of the common cause; and the governor and council are further empowered and requested to cause one or more of the gallies and armed boats to be fitted out and manned with all possible expedition,
