pelled by the enemy to leave his habitation, and be thereby rendered CHAP. incapable to carry on his business or occupation, or hath lost his negrees by means of the enemy, or otherwise greatly suffered, the governor and the council may direct the collectors not to collect the afsession from such person, until the general assembly shall take order therein.

III. And be it enative, That five fensible, discreet, and experienced five commissioners to be persons, shall be appointed in each county of this state, who shall be appointed in called commissioners of the tax, and they or any three or more of them &c. shall be the commissioners for each county.
