An ACT for the regulation of officers fees,

THEREAS officers fees can be rated, regulated, and establish-Preamble. ed, by act of affembly only, and fuch an act is now expedient and necessary:

II. Be it enasted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That no of-Officers not to ficer or officers hereafter mentioned in this present act, their ministers, sees than hereservants, or deputies, by reason or colour of his or their office or offices, after limitted, shall have, receive, or take, of any person or persons, directly or indirectly, any other or greater fees, which shall arise or become due after the commencement of this act, than are hereafter limitted and allowed to the several officers herein mentioned, under the penalty of fifty pounds current money for every offence: That is to say,
