any fatted cattle or hogs by any butcher; with intent to flaughter at the place of his usual residence, to be sold in the county where he resides, or the buying flour of any kind by any baker, for manufacturing or felling by retail; in any quantity not exceeding twenty-eight pounds to any one person at any one time, to the inhabitants of any city or town in the vicinity thereof, shall not be deemed, construed, or taken, to be within the intent and meaning of this act...

CHAP.

XX. And be it enaced. That no person shall be permitted to act No person to within this state as commissary-general, agent, quarter-master-general, fary-general, or as deputy to either, for the United States, before such person or &c. until lipersons have been licensed by the governor and council of this state; governor and and all persons applying for such licence shall produce their commission council, & to the governor and council, if the tame hath not been already done, who, on examination thereof, shall cause the date of such commission and the name of the person producing the same to be entered on their proceedings, and also the district in which such person so licensed as asoresaid shall be permitted to exercise his office; and the governor and council are hereby requested to transmit to the clerks of the several counties, a list of the names of all persons by them licensed as aforefaid, and the diffrict in which they are permitted to purchase, which faid lift shall be deposited among the records of each county, and shall also publish the names and districts of the persons so licensed in the Annapolis and Baltimore gazeties, that the same may be known to the inhabitants of this state.

XXI. And he it enaded, That the governor and the council be au- Governor and thorifed and requested to lay out and divide the several counties of this vide the counstate into eight districts, of which five shall be laid out on the western ties into eight and three on the eastern shore, and may also appoint and assign one of districts, &c. the deputies licensed as aforesaid to exercise his office in one of the aforetaid districts; and if any person or persons, so appointed and licensed, shall exercise his said office in any other district than that to which he is affigned, or shall act as deputy without being licensed as aforefaid, he shall forfeit and pay for every offence the sum of ten thousand pounds.

XXII. Provided nevertheless, That nothing herein contained shall Provide be construed or taken to prohibit the commissary or deputy-commissary-generals, the quarter-master or deputy quarter-master-generals, of the United States, from purchasing any of the articles aforesaid in any part of this state.

XXIII. and, Whereas it is represented to this general assembly, that fundry persons in this state have withheld and refused to sell their wheat of the growth of the preceding years, by means whereof the fly and other destructive vermin have been produced and encreased, to the great detriment of the public:

XXIV. Be it therefore enasted, That it shall and may be lawful for justice may any one justice of the peace in any county of this state, and he is hereby authorised and required, on his own knowledge, or on information on years to be cath, that any person or persons have by them any wheat of the growth seized, &c. and produce of any of the preceding years, to issue his warrant, empowering.
