adjusted, the said commissioners shall, on or before the twentieth day of April next, enclose and endorse for the public service, and deliver to the sherisf of their respective counties, to be by them forwarded as public letters to the treasurer of his shore.

CHAP.

XXXVIII. And be it enafted, That all the certificates of assessment Certificates of high shall by the said affestors be delivered to the said assessment, &c. which shall by the said affessors be delivered to the said commissioners, to be lodged and all the books of proceedings of the faid commissioners, and the ac- with the county clerks; counts by them settled with the several collectors aforesaid, shall be by &c. the said commissioners delivered to the clerk of their respective counties, on or before the first day of May next, under the penalty of one hundred and fifty pounds current money, to be by the said clerk lodged in his office, and carefully kept for the inspection of the inhabitants of fuch county, for and during the term of fix months from the day of the receipt thereof into his said office; and the said clerk shall, within five days after the expiration of the faid fix months, under the penalty of one hundred pounds current money, enclose and deliver the said certificates, books, proceedings and accounts, to the sheriff of such respective county, safely enclosed, and endorsed for the public service, directed to the clerk of the house of delegates, to be by the said sheriff forwarded as public letters, and under the like penalty; and the faid clerk shall safely keep the said certificates, books, proceedings and accounts, in his office, until the next meeting of the assembly, and shall, on the second day thereof, lay them before the house of delegates, for the inspection of the members thereof.

XXXIX. And be it enacted, That if any of the days appointed by Days for perthis act for performance of any of the duties thereby required shall hap- ties falling on pen to be on a Sunday, then fuch duties shall be performed on the day sunday, dufollowing, any thing herein contained to the contrary notwithstanding. formed next

XL. And be it enaued, That the collector of each respective county Commissionshall, at the time of settlement of his accounts as aforesaid, pay to fors falary, each of the faid commissioners who shall serve in the execution of this &c. act, as a salary for the sull and faithful performance of their duty therein, seven pounds ten shillings for each day they shall necessarily attend in the performance of the several services required of them by this act, and shall also pay to the said commissioners, for the use of their clerk, seven pounds ten shillings per day for every day he shall be necessarily employed in the performance of his duty, and for the use of the said assessors, for the full and faithful performance of their duty under this act, any sum not under fifty pounds nor exceeding one hundred and fifty pounds current money, for each affessor, which the said commissioners shall adjudge an adequate reward for the service of each assessor. And the amount of all the sums so paid shall, by the said commissioners, be allowed to the faid collector on settlement of his account as aforesaid, in which account shall be expressed the name of the clerk, and the names of the affestors for each hundred, and the sum of money to them respectively allowed. And the said commissioners shall, after receipt of the said sums for the use of their clerk and of the said assessors, pay the same to them or their orders respectively on demand, uncer the penalty of one hundred and fifty pounds current money to the party grieved.
