

III. And be it enacted, That for the inspection of every hoghead of tobacco, the inspector or inspectors at each respective inspection, shall be entitled to receive thirty-two shillings and six-pence at the time of inspection, from the owner or person bringing the same.

C H A P. XLI, XLII.

Inspectors allowance, &c.

IV. And be it enacted, That the inspector or inspectors shall receive from every person or persons, exporting tobacco from any inspection-house to which he or they are appointed; the sum of forty shillings for each hoghead so exported, out of which sum, so received, the inspector or inspectors shall pay to the proprietor or proprietors of the warehouse, to which he or they is appointed aforesaid, the sum of twenty shillings, and shall account to the justices of the county for the residue, to be applied by them towards discharging the county charge.

C H A P. XLII.

An A C T for the payment of the journal of accounts.

W H E R E A S it appears by the journal of accounts and list of debts, that there is now due from this state the sum of sixty-six thousand five hundred and thirty-four pounds seven shillings and eight-pence :

Preamble.

II. Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the treasurer of the western shore shall, and he is hereby authorized and required to deliver out of the bills of credit which now are or shall be in his hands, for the use of this state, to the several persons, their executors, administrators, assigns or orders, or to such of them as shall offer to receive the same, the several sums of money allowed to them respectively, as they appear to be stated and ascertained by the journal of accounts and list of debts aforesaid.

Treasurer of W. shore to pay the journal of accounts.

III. And be it enacted, That all or any of the public creditors on the journal may have their election to receive a certificate or certificates from the treasurer of the western shore, signed by him, and expressing the sum due to such creditor or creditors, which shall be discounted by the sheriff of the county where such person or persons may reside, in payment of the taxes due on the present assessment acts, or any future assessments.
