

A supplement to the act, entitled, An act for securing the title of the proprietors of lots and houses in Charles-town, in Charles county.

W H E R E A S, by the act for securing the title of proprietors of lots and houses in Charles-town, in Charles county, passed at a session of assembly, begun and held at the city of Annapolis, the eighth day of November, seventeen hundred and seventy-nine, the commissioners appointed by the said act were directed to meet on or before the fifteenth day of March then following, for the purposes therein mentioned: And whereas the act by which the said meeting was directed to be held did not reach the said county in time to be executed: Preamble.

II. Be it therefore enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the commissioners appointed by the aforesaid act shall, on or before the first day of August next, meet at Charles-town aforesaid, and having so met, shall have full and ample power and authority to do, execute, and perform, the several things and duties required of them by the said act, and when done, shall be deemed, taken, and considered, as good and effectual in law, as though they had been performed within the time appointed by the said law, any thing therein contained to the contrary notwithstanding. Commissioners to meet before August 1, &c.

C H A P. XXI.

An A C T to continue the acts of assembly therein mentioned.

B E it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That an act of assembly for amending and repairing the public roads in Baltimore county, made at a session of assembly, begun and held at the city of Annapolis, on Saturday the first day of November, one thousand seven hundred and sixty-six, be and is hereby continued, and shall be and remain in full force, for and during the term of one year, and to the end of the next session of assembly which shall happen after the end of the said one year. That one other act of assembly, entitled, An act for the relief of insolvent debtors, made at a session of assembly, begun and held at the city of Annapolis, on Wednesday the twenty-third day of March, seventeen hundred and seventy-four, be and is hereby continued, and shall be and remain in full force, for and during the term of seven years, and to the end of the next session of assembly which shall happen after the end of the said seven years. That one other act of assembly, entitled, An act to prohibit for a limited time the exportation of wheat, flour, rye, Indian corn, rice, bread, beef, pork, bacon, live stock, peas, beans, oats, and other victual, made at a session of assembly, begun and held at the city of Annapolis, on Monday the eighth day of November, seventeen hundred and seventy-nine, be and is hereby continued, and shall be and remain in full force, until the end of the next session of assembly. And that one other act of assembly, entitled, An act for the enlarging the powers of the governor and council, and a supplement to the act, entitled, An act for enlarging Four acts and a supplement to an act continued.
