XI. And be it enacted, That the persons heretofore appointed by the governor and council, and the persons nominated by this act to solicit and receive loans, shall be subject to the directions of the governor and council, and the said persons are hereby directed to transmit, as soon as possible, all money, crop notes, or specie, by them received, to the treasurer of their shire; and the governor and council are requested to cause one million two hundred and thirty-four thousand three hundred and fifty dollars of the paper money by them collected, to be conveyed, with all expedition, to the continental treasury, and to direct that the subscriptions cease, as soon as sufficient sums shall be procured to answer the requisition of congress of the nineteenth of May, and such further requisitions for supplies as shall be made by the committee of congress.

C H A P. III.

An A C T for a new and speedy enrollment of the militia.

Preamble.

**W**HEREAS, since the last enrollment of the militia, many have died, or removed from this state, or the county where they lived, and many inhabitants have since arrived to the age required by law to enter into the militia:

II. Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the lieutenant of each county (calling to his advice and assistance the field officers and the commanding officer of each company of the militia of his county, the assessors, the clerk and high sheriff of the county, or such or so many of them as he may think proper, at a day by him to be appointed, as soon as possible after the receipt of this act, for their meeting, at the place of holding the court for his county, or such other place as he shall think more convenient) shall proceed to make out a new list of all the able bodied persons in his county capable to perform militia duty, and required to be enrolled in the militia, by the act to regulate the militia, and every person, whose name shall be entered on such list, shall thereafter be deemed and taken to be one of the enrolled militia of such county, and liable to all penalties, imposed, or hereafter to be imposed, for any neglect of duty, and the lieutenant shall appoint to what company and class of militia such persons shall belong.

III. And, Whereas some persons may escape from being enrolled as above directed:

IV. Be it enacted, That the lieutenant of every county, on his own knowledge, or good information, that any person has been omitted to be entered on the list aforesaid, or that any one has since removed into his county, or arrived to proper age, may, and he is hereby required to add the name of such person to the list of the militia of his county, and thereupon such person shall be deemed and taken to be one of the militia of such county, and liable to all penalties imposed, or hereafter to be imposed, for any neglect of duty.
