fach debts, until the first day of the next term in the month of May next, at which term the chancellor and judges, or a majority of them, if any further depreciation shall have taken place, may again ascertain the depreciation or exchange or difference as aforesaid, and the standard of exchange, so to be ascertained, shall be the rule of tender or payment of all such debts; and the county courts in all actions before them shall be bound and govern themselves by the exchange to be determined and ascertained as aforesaid; and the chancellor and the judges, or a majority of them, may at each term thereaster (during the time the said new bills shall continue in circulation) ascertain the exchange, as asoresaid, at which the said new bills may be tendered or paid for such debts, until the next term after such determination, which they shall cause to be published in the Annapolis and Baltimore news-papers, for the information and government of all concerned.

An ACT to continue the acts of affembly therein mentioned.

E it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That an act of Four acts and assembly, entitled, An act for the enlarging the powers of the continued, governor and council, made at a session of assembly, begun and held at the city of Annapolis, on Monday the eighth day of November, seventeen hundred and seventy-nine, and a suplement to the act, entitled, An act for enlarging the powers of the governor and council, passed at the same session, be and they are hereby continued, and shall be and remain in full force until the end of the next session of assembly.
