

either in specie or the said bills of credit, to the treasurer of the western shore; and that any person possessed of any sum of the said bills of credit, not less than one hundred pounds, may deliver the same into the treasury of either shore, and the treasurer, who receives the same of such subscriber or other person, shall give a receipt for such money, expressing therein, that the same was paid in on account of the party's subscription, or as possessor of the said bills, as the case may be; and in case the party pays the same on account of his subscription, he shall be entitled to, and the receipt shall express, that interest of eight per cent. per annum shall be paid thereon; and in case the party pays in the same as the possessor thereof, such person shall be allowed, and the receipt shall express, that interest of six per cent. per annum shall be paid thereon; and any subscriber who shall pay in as aforesaid shall be discharged of his subscription for so much, and the bearers of any receipts obtained by possessors as aforesaid, shall be entitled to receive the principal and interest due in specie, as if they had brought in the bills of credit aforesaid within the days appointed for bringing in the same.

XIII. AND, To secure the faithful and punctual payment of the said bills,

XIV. Be it enacted, That the following property within this state, of persons well known to this general assembly to be British subjects, within the description and intent of the act of the last session of assembly, to seize, confiscate, and appropriate, all British property within this state, that is to say: The several manors in the counties of Saint Mary's, Kent, Charles, Queen-Anne's, Dorchester, Somerset, and Worcester, which belonged to the late lord proprietary, and which remain unsold by the commissioners of Frederick late lord Baltimore, and also all the property of the persons commonly called by the name of the Principio company, except the part, share, or interest, of Thomas Russell, a subject of this state, and one of the said company, and except also the part, share, or interest, of any other subject of this, or any subject of any other of the United States, and further excepting out of the said property of the Principio company the land on Whetstone-point, and also two hundred acres of the land of the said company on Patapsco river near Harris's creek, which two hundred acres are to be laid off by the commissioners herein after mentioned; and also all the property within this state of Anthony Bacon, John Eversfield, Andrew Buchanan, James Brown and company, Mackie, Spears and company, Mackie, Spears, French and company, James Christie, John Buchanan, John Glassford and company, the heirs of John Hyde, the heirs of Samuel Hyde, and the heirs of Thomas Bladen; and also the property within this state of the several persons following, who left this state before the formation of the new government, and appear to this general assembly, by presentment of the grand jury of the general court, to have adhered to the enemy, and thereby have elected to be British subjects, to wit: Daniel Dulany, son of Daniel, Daniel Dulany, son of Walter, and Henry Addison, clerk, Jonathan Boucher, clerk, and Anthony Stewart; excepting out of the said Henry Addison his lands and other property in Prince-George's, excepting out of the property of the said Daniel Dulany, son of Walter, the real and personal property held by him in company or as a partner with others in iron-works, and also the five hundred acres of land, or thereabouts, on
