C H A P. XXXIV.

A Supplement to the act for the defence of the bay.

E it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That for the Governor and immediate defence of the bay, and to prevent, as far as may be, purchase a I the depredations of the enemy, the governor and council be au-gailey, &c. thorised and empowered to purchase, at such price as they may think reasonable, the galley now in Baltimore-town, mentioned in the memorial of the inhabitants of said town, if on examination by such proper person as they may appoint, she shall be found to be found and fit for the service, to be completely finished, fitted and manned at the public expence; and that they have power to contract for the building another galley, agreeable to the act of assembly of the last session, and cause her to be completely fitted and manned at the public expence; both of which gallies to be employed in such manner as the governor and council shall from time to time direct, for the defence of our bay and the protection of the trade thereof; and fuch gallies, when not in actual service, shall be unrigged, and kept in some lase harbour, under the care of some person or persons, to be appointed by the governor and council, until they are again wanted for the public defence.

II. Be it enacted, That the governor and council be authorised and To contract empowered to contract for any number of barges, not exceeding eight, that they may think necessary for the defence of this bay, and to cause them to be completely fitted and manned.

III. And he it enaued, That the governor and council be authorifed To appropriate and empowered to appropriate twenty-fix thousand fix hundred and fix-defence of the ty-fix pounds thirteen shillings and four-pence, of the bills of credit state, &c. emitted by the act for the emission of bills of credit not exceeding two hundred thousand pounds, on the security of double the value in lands, to defray the expences of the present campaign, to the immediate defence of this state, in fitting out gallies and barges, or in any other manner of defence they may judge most expedient.

A Supplement to the act to fettle and adjust the accounts of the troops of this state in the service of the United States, and for other purposes therein mentioned.

THEREAS doubts have been entertained by the commist- Preamble. fioner appointed to fettle and adjust the accounts of the troops of this state, with respect to the time to which the faid depreciation should be carried.

II. Fe it enaced, by the General Affembly of Maryland, That the How turns received fined faid commissioner shall adjust the accounts of the troops of this state, July are to be and settle for all sums of money received since the month of July last, settled, &c. according to the table of depreciation contained in the act to adjust the debts due from this state.
