That another act of assembly, entitled, An act to continue an act, entitled, An act for the regulation of officers fees, and for other purposes, made at a session of assembly begun and held at the city of Annapolis on Tuesday the seventeenth day of October seventeen hundred and eighty, be and is hereby continued and shall be and remain in full force until the first day of October seventeen hundred and eighty three, and to the end of the next session of assembly which shall happen thereafter. That another act of assembly, entitled, A Supplement to the act for the regulation of the staple of tobacco, made at a session of assembly begun and held at the city of Annapolis on Tuesday the seventeenth day of October seventeen hundred and eighty, and an additional Supplement to the act for the regulation of the staple of tobacco, made at a session of assembly begun and held at the city of Annapolis on Thursday the tenth day of May seventeen hundred and eighty one, be and they are hereby continued and shall be and remain in full force until the end of the next session of assembly. That another act of assembly, entitled, An act for the speedy conveyance of public letters and packets, and for other purposes, made at a session of assembly begun and held at the city of Annapolis on Tuesday the seventeenth day of October seventeen hundred and eighty, be and is hereby continued and shall be and remain in full force for and during the term of three years, and to the end of the next session of assembly which shall happen thereafter. That all those parts of one other act of assembly, entitled, An act concerning estates tail, and the jurisdiction of the county courts, made at a session of assembly begun and held at the city of Annapolis on Tuesday the fifteenth day of June one thousand seven hundred and seventy-three, which relate to the jurisdiction of the county courts, be and they are hereby continued until the end of the next session of assembly.
