form of government, or any law or laws in force within this state, any CHAP. law, custom, or usage, to the contrary notwithstanding.

C H A P. XIX.

An additional Supplement to an act, entitled, An act to unite the free-schools of Saint Mary's, Charles, and Prince-George's counties,

HEREAS it is represented to the general assembly, that Preamble. the trustees for Charlotte-Hall school have purchased lands for the said school, but have by experience found at extremely difficult to procure a sufficient number of trustees to meet for transacting the business of the said school:

II. Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That any Five trustees five or more of the said trustees, with or without the president, shall may act, acc. be and are hereby empowered to meet at the said school from time to time, and they or the major part of them so met, may do any act, matter, or thing, which the said president and trustees might do, any law to the contrary notwithstanding.

C H A P. WXX.

An ACT to prevent the raising of swine and geese in the town of Vienna, in Dorchester county.

HEREAS it is represented to this general assembly; that Preamble. fundry persons, inhabiting and residing in the town of Vienna, in Dorchester county, do raise and keep a great number of gerse and swine in the said town, to the great detriment of the inhabitants thereof:

II. Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That no per-Persons not to son or persons whatsoever, living, or that shall hereaster live, in the sec. said town, shall, after the end of this present session of assembly, under any pretence whatsoever, keep or support in the said town, any swine or geese belonging to themselves, or any other person whatsoever, unless such swine and geese he kept within such person or persons enclosure to whom the same shall respectively belong.

III. And be it enacted, That in case any person or persons whatso-swine, &c. go-ever, living, or that shall hereafter live, in the said town, shall, after may be shot, the end of this present session of assembly, suffer any swine or geese belonging to themselves, or to any other person and under their case, to go at large in the said town, it shall and may be lawful for any person to shoot or otherwise destroy such swine and geese so tound at large; and moreover, any person or persons suffering any swine or geese to go at large as aforesaid, shall fortest and pay for every offence the sum of forty shillings current money, to be recovered before a single magistrate, for the use of the informer, or person that shall sue for the same.
