XV. Be it enaited, That the persons incorporated by this act shall CNAP. XXIII. begin the canal at or near Love-island, on or before the first day of 7. XX Y. When conditio October next, and carry on the same with diligence till it reaches tide water, and fully complete the canal, according to the directions of this act, within seven years, and on failure or neglect to perform the same within the time aforefaid, this act to be null, void, and of no effect.

XVI. Be it enacted, That the owners of lands through which the come funteria scanal may pais, thall have full liberty to become subscribers for making the laid canal, at any time before the first day of June next, provided such application be made before the subscriptions be filled up and completed.

An ACT respecting theatrical entertainments.

Preamble.

> HEREAS it is the duty of government to prevent, as far as may be, the exhibition of indecent or immoral theatrical entertainments,

Theatrical entertainments.

II. Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That no thenot to be ex. atrical enterrainments shall hereafter be exhibited, unless by licence hibited with- from the governor, and every person who shall persorm as an actor or actress in such entertainment, without such licence, shall forfelt and pay, for every offence, the sum of fifty pounds. Provided, that nothing in this act is meant to extend to deprive the street or special commissioners of Baltimore town, in Baltimore county, from recovering or levying the tax on the play-house in said town, the manager, actor, or actors therein, conforming to this act, nor from licenshing all other public exhibitions within said town, agreeably to an act, entitled, An act for the more effectual paving the streets of Baltimoretown, in Baltimore county.

New plays, &c not to be acted, &c.

III. And be it enacted, That from and after the tenth day of January next, no person shall, for hire, gain or reward, act, persorm, represent, or cause to be acted, performed or represented, any new interlude, tragedy, comedy, opera, play, farce, or other entertainment of the stage, or any part or parts therein, or any new act, scene or other part, added to any old interlude, tragedy, comedy, opera, play, farce, or other entertainment of the stage, or any new prologue or epilogue, unless a true copy thereof be sent to the governor ten days at least before the acting, representing, or performing thereof, together with an account of the play-house, or other place, where the same shall be, and the time when the same is to be first acted, represented or performed, figned by the master or manager.

Governor may prohibit acting, &cc.

IV. And be it enacted, That from and after the tenth day of January next, it shall and may be lawful to and for the governor, from time to time, and when and as often as he shall think fit, to prohibit the acting, performing or representing, any interlude, tragedy, comedy, opera, play, farce, or other entertainment of the stage, or any act, icene, or part thereof, or any prologue or epilogue; and in case any person or persons shall act, persorm or represent, or cause to be acted, any
