C H A P. XL.

A Supplement to an act, entitled, An act to appoint an intendant of the revenue.

Act revived,  
&c.

**B**E it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the act, entitled, An act to appoint an intendant of the revenue, passed November session seventeen hundred and eighty-two, shall be and is hereby revived and continued in full force until the end of the next session of assembly, and the intendant of the revenue therein mentioned is hereby continued, and vested with the same powers, and shall be under the same penalties and restrictions to the state, as is given or contained in the before recited act; and shall give the same securities for the diligent and faithful performance of the several duties, as is required by the act aforesaid.

II. And be it enacted, That all accounts hereafter liquidated and passed by the auditor-general shall be presented to the intendant, and if passed by him shall be entered on his books, and he is hereby empowered to draw an order or orders on the treasury for the same, which order or orders, and account, shall be carried back to the auditor, and by him entered on his books.

III. And be it enacted, That the salaries to the office of intendant and auditor for the present year, be continued in the same proportion for the ensuing year, and that they be paid in the same manner as civil officers for the ensuing year shall be paid.

C H A P. XLI.

An A C T to establish a warehouse for the reception and inspection of tobacco, at Hamburg, on Wiccomico river, in Saint Mary's county.

Preamble.

**W**H E R E A S it is represented to this general assembly, that the proprietors of the land, at a place on Wiccomico river, in Saint Mary's county, known by the name of the Indian Town, but now called Hamburg, are willing to erect, at their own cost and expence, a convenient warehouse for the reception and inspection of tobacco, at the place aforesaid.

Warehouse to  
be built, &c.

II. Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That provided the proprietors of the land at Hamburg, their heirs or successors, erect, within twelve months from the passage of this act, at their own cost and expence, a good and sufficient warehouse, and keep the same in repair, the same shall be considered and established as a public warehouse, and subject to the same regulations as all public warehouses are within this state.

III. And be it enacted, That the said warehouse, when built, shall be under the inspection of the inspector or inspectors at Chaptico, who shall attend one day in every week at the said warehouse, to inspect all tobaccos that may be brought to the said warehouse for his or their inspection; and the said inspector or inspectors shall attend at the said warehouse
