ample powers of execution as the faid Simon Nichols had or might have CHAP. had while collector of Montgomery county, and that the perion so appointed, may be authorifed to call on the faid Simon Nichols, and all deputies by him appointed or concerned in the collections aforefaid, for a lettlement of and upon their books and accounts with the inhabitants of Montgomery county, relative to the transactions aforesaid, and that the faid Simon Nichols may be compelled to deliver up to the person so appointed, all fuch books, accounts, papers and vouchers, in the possession of the faid Simon Nichols, or his deputies, as he may require, or may be necessary to enable the person so appointed to make such final collection and tettlement, and that a reasonable time may be given to the person so appointed for that purpose; and it appearing to this general assembly that the prayer of the said petition is highly reasonable, and that the public interest, as well as the security of the petitioner, requires a compliance therewith,

II. Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Alexander Collector ap-Catlett be, and he is hereby appointed, collector of the residue of the pointed, &c. public taxes now remaining due and unfatisfied in the county aforefaid, for the years seventeen hundred and eighty, seventeen hundred and eightyone, and seventeen hundred and eighty-two, in the room of the faid Simon Nichols; and the faid Alexander Catlett is hereby fully authorised and empowered to receive and collect, by execution or otherwise, all arrears and balances due the said Simon Nichols, as collector of the county aforesaid, in as full and ample manner as the faid Simon Nichols might or could have received or collected the same, during the time of his being collector of the public taxes in the county aforefaid; and the faid Alexander Catlett is hereby vested with the whole power and authority which the said simon Nichols had or possessed under the laws of this state, as collector of the public taxes, and for the purposes of receiving and collecting the same, during the time he was collector of Montgomery county aforesaid.

III. And he it enacted, That the said Simon Nichols do and shall, Books, &c. upon the request of the said Alexander Catlett, deliver to the said Alex to the delivered, &c. ander Catlett all and every the books, accounts, papers, memorandums, and vouchers, of the faid Simon Nichols, which in any manner relate to or concern the faid public taxes, or the receipt or collection thereof; and the several and respective deputies, agents, or receivers, of the said Simon Nichols, engaged or appointed by him, or acting as such, or in any manner concerned in the receipt or collection of the faid public taxes under the faid Simon Nichols, or by virtue of his authority, or in his name, or otherwise, do and shall, at the request of, and when called upon by, the said Alexander Catlett, upon their respective oaths produce, shew, explain to and lay before him, all the books, accounts, memorandums; papers, and vouchers, whatfoever, of the said agents, deputies, receivers, or others, so concerned as aforesaid, and make and deliver necessary copies and extracts thereof to the faid Alexander Catlett, for the purpose of settling and adjusting all accounts, claims, and demands, relative to the taxes aforesaid.

And be it enacted, That if the said Simon Nichols shall refuse or Commissionneglect, when called upon by the said Alexander Catlett, to comply with ers may order the directions of this act, the commissioners of the tax for Montgomery &cc. county be, and they are hereby empowered and required, on the application of the said Alexander Catlett, to order the sum for which the said Simon Nichols is in arrear to the state as collector for the said county, to be paid to the said Catlett, either immediately or on a short day to be limited; and may also carry such order into effect, by their warrant, directed to the sheriff, to levy the said sum, in the same manner as by siers
