may be of opinion Mr. Harford is interested in, and are of a private nature only; and that the governor and council be requested to permit Mr. Hartord to have access to any other papers in their possession, which they may think connected with the late proprietary revenue, and which they may judge proper that Mr. Harford foould have access to.
