An additional supplement to the act: to prevent the exportation of Passed Many unmerchantable tobacco.

HEREAS many of the inspectors of tobacco at the several warehouses Preamble. within this state baye resulted to inspect purcels of cobacco, and so grant transfer notes for the same;

II. Be it ensked, by the general affembly of Maryland, That when any tobacco Tobacco shall hereafter be brought in parcels to any warehouse in this state, appointed by brought in law for the miblic recention and infraction of tables observed to be hw for the public reception and inspection of tobacco, the inspector or inspectors viewed, ac. are hereby directed carefully to view and examine the same, and if found to be in good condition and merchantable, to weigh and render to the owner thereof as many transfer notes as he or the may require, to the amount of the quantity for examined and weighed, which notes shall be current, and received in payment and satisfaction of all contracts for tobacco, and judgments and decrees on contracts for tobacco, subject to the usual deduction of the per cent. when paid or reesivethin lieu, of crop tobacco, and of ten per cent. when paid or received in lieu of cropy tobacco clear of reask, according to the terms and intention of the contract, judgment or decree, as the case may be, and shall be transferrable from one to another in all such tobacco payments, and shall be paid and satisfied by the inspection or inspectors, who signed the same, upon demand, and the said inspector or inspectors shall and are hereby obliged to make every hog head by himtor them paid away in discharge of notes given by him, or them, as aforesaid; to contain nine hundred, pounds of net tobacgo at lexit; and for every fuch hogshead of tobacco by him or them paid a ways well lined and nailed in he order for thipping. there shall be paid by the person receiving such hogshead the sum of nine shillings and foun-pence for calls and gails, and the person demanding or receiving tobacco in discharge of notes as aspresaid, shall allow the inspector of inspectors two gounds of tobacco per hundred, and in proportion for any, greater or finalled quantity, for thrinkage and waste, if the said tobacco be paid at any time within two months after the date of the note or notes given for the same, and one pound of tobacco for every hundred for every month in which the same shall be unpaid after the faid allowance, so as such all wance for thrinkage and waste does not. exceeding the whole his pounds for every hundred pounds of tobacco; and if any inspector or inspectors, by whom any such notes for, tobacco, as aforesaid shall be figned. shall refuse or delay to pay and, satisfy the same when demanded, every inspector so resusing or delaying shall forseit and pay to the party injured double the value of the type equ to refuted or delayed to be paid, to be recovered with costs, if the noteror notes so resuled or delayed to be gaid exceed six: hundred pounds of tobacco, and if the mote or notes do not exceed fix hundred pounds of tobacco, double the value shell and may be recovered before any justice of the peace of the county wherein the warehouse shall be, at which the note or notes ought to ba paid.

III. And be it enamed, That the owner of any transfer notes may at any times owner of transfer notes receive and mark hogsheads of tobacco for satisfying such notes; and the inspector may mark or inspectors shall take in his or their former notes, and deliver crop notes and re- hoghests, cciptsifor-luch hogheads, and hall be answerable for the lase-keeping spersof in the fame manner as they are for crop tobacco, but the perfon, receiving fuch hoghead hall pay to the inspector the sure of pine shillings and fews gones for
