An ACT for the appointment of, and conferring powers in, deputies from this state to the federal convention.

Deputies appointed to meet in convention, &c.

E it enaged, by the general assembly of Maryland, That the honourable James M'Henry, Daniel of Saint Thomas Jeniser, Daniel Carroll, John D Francis Mercer, and Luther Martin, Esquires, be appointed and authorifed, on hehalf of this state, to meet, such deputies as may be appointed and authorifed by any other of the United States to assemble in convention at Philadelphia, for the purpose of revising the sederal system, and to join with them in considering such alterations, and surther provisions, as may be necessary to render the federal constitution adequate to the exigencies of the union, and in reporting fuch an act for that purpose to the United States in congress assembled, as, when agreed to by them, and duly confirmed by the several states, will effectually provide for the same; and the said deputies, or such, of shem as shall attend the said convention, shall have full power to represent this state for the purposes aforesaid; and the faid deputies are hereby directed to report the proceedings of the faid con-
