CHAP. of the account of the faid tax, for which he thall be liable under this act, shall be enforced by the same mode of proceeding as prescribed by law for recovery from the other collectors of the tax for the same year within this state.

On refusal to act, governor and council to appoint, &c.

III. And he it enacted. That if the faid Zachariah Duvall shall neglect or result to act, the governor and council shall appoint such other person as they shall approve, to execute the duties by this act imposed on the said Zachariah Duvall; and that the said person so to be appointed by the governor and council shall give bond, with such security as the governor and council shall approve, and that the commissioners shall settle the account of the said person so to be appointed in the same manner as they are directed by this act to settle with the said Zachariah Duvall; and that the payment of the money which shall be due from the said person to be appointed in virtue of this act, shall, after the said days respectively, be enforced in the same manner as is prescribed by law for the recovery of taxes from the other collectors for the year seventeen hundred and eighty-six.

Collector to collect the fund tax, &c.

IV. And he it enamed. That the faid Zachariah Duvall, or upon his neglect or refusal to act, the collector to be appointed by the governor and council under this act, shall be and is hereby authorised and empowered, upon his giving security to be approved as aforesaid, to collect the sund tax for the years seventeen hundred and eighty-six, seventeen hundred and eighty-seven, and seventeen hundred and eighty-eight, in the same manner as the other collectors in this state are authorised and empowered to collect the said tax, and the same proceedings shall be had to settle the account of the said fund tax, and to compet the payment of the said fund tax in the proportion and at the times limited by this act, as are prescribed for the settling the account and compelling the payment of the tax for the year seventeen hundred and eighty-six.

And may appoint deputies, &c.

V. And he it enaces, That the said Zachariah Davall, or the person to be appointed under this act, in case of his resulas or neglect to act. shall be and is hereby authorised to appoint one or more deputies for executing the purposes of this act, and shall have the same proceeding to compel a settlement and payment by his deputies, and their securities, that the other collectors in this states have by law against their deputies and securities.

Two per cent. to be aflessed, &c.

VI. And he it enacted, That the two per cent. allowed for extra commission to the collector appointed by this act, be assessed on the districts in Anne-Arundel county for which he is collector.

C H A P. XVI.

An additional supplementary act to the act, entitled, An act for building a new church in the city of Annapolis.

Preamble.

HER-BAS the trustees appointed to build the said church were directed by the aforesaid original act to build an elegant church, adomed with a steaple, the expence whereof was estimated at six thousand pounds current money, one half thereof to be raised by subscription, and the other half to be paid by the public and the parishioners equally: And whereas it appears to this general assembly, that the said trustees, in obedience to the aforesaid act, in the year seventeen hundred and seventy-six; purchased materials to a large amount, most of which, during the war, were taken and carried away. partly by individuals, and partly by the order of the council of safety, for the construction of batteries, barracks, and other public uses; that during the ware the faid trustees were obliged to defist from the further profecution of the work; that by a supplementary act passed in the year seventeen bundred and eighty-five it the said trustees were directed to proceed on the execution of the trust reposed inc them, and to call on all persons who had any of the materials, and oblight thems to account and pay for the same, and to open new subscriptions; that in compliance with the directions of the faid act, the faid truffees have procured a liberal subscription, to the amount of three thousand sous hundred and fifty four pounds,
