E it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That in case any sheriff Judgment or coroner shall be called upon by order of any court of record within may be enterthis state, or of the high court of chancery, to make return of any writ ed against any of execution, and shall fail or omit to make return thereof within the time in certain limitted by rule of court made for that purpose, it shall and may be lawful to cases, &c. and for the judges aforesaid to cause judgment to be entered up, in the name of the plaintiff or plaintiffs, against such sheriff or coroner, for the amount of the debt or damages, and costs, recovered from the person or persons against whose body, goods, chattels, lands or tenements, such execution shall have issued, which judgment shall have the same effect, operation and validity, as any judgement rendered upon any verdict of a jury.
