And be it enacted, That the commissioners aforesaid shall not have power Road not to to open the said road through the land of any proprietor without his or her conwithout consent, until the expiration of twelve months next after the making of the award sent, &c. aforesaid, or in case of the intervention of a jury until the expiration of twelve months after the return as aforesaid of their inquisition, and moreover until the damages ascertained as aforesaid shall have been paid, or tender thereof made.
