And be it enacted, That all and fingular the fections, clauses, provisions Sections, &c and penalties, in anywife relating to the infection of flour and examination of extended, &co alks, which are contained in the faid act, entitled, An act to prevent the exporstion of bread and flour not merchantable, and for other purposes, be and they are hereby extended to the port of Chester, and to the regulation of the inspecion of flour within faid port, in as full and ample a manner as if the same had been herein particularly specified and mentioned.

VI. And be it enafted, That the said chief justice and associate justices, or Justices to the major part of them, shall meet, at some convenient place within said town, between the first and last days of March next, and between the same days yearly and every year thereafter during the continuance of this act, and then and there nominate and appoint a person of good repute, well skilled in the goodness, quahis and well curing of falted beef, pork and fish, of every kind, to be inspectors of falted provisions within the faid port for the year entuing.

VII. Und be it enaced. That every chief justice and associate justice who chiet justice, full vote for the faid otheer, before he shall proceed to the nomination and ap- &c. to take an oath, &c communent of faid officer, thall take the following oath, or affirmation if a quaker, before some justice of the peace in Kent county, or each before the other, viz. "I, A. B. do swear, or affirm, that I will faithfully, honestly and impar-"tially, nominate and appoint such person to be inspector of salted provisions "within the faid port of Chester as I think in my judgment and conscience is sit "and capable of executing the faid office;" and in case of the death, refutal, or negled to act, of the faid person so appointed inspector of salted provisions, his neancy thall be filled up in the manner and as is herein before directed and provided in the case of the inspector of flour.
