sould confiderably lessen the sum necessary to be levied for the purpose of pur- CHAP. gassing the above-mentioned lot adjoining to the said court-house; therefore, it enacted, That Thomas Jones, Levin Woolford and Richard Pattison, Commissionbiquires, or any two of them, shall be and they are hereby appointed commission appointed, toners, and are authorised and empowered to contract for the sale of the seeimple of the above-mentioned lots now leased on ground-rent, on a credit not exceeding twelve months, taking a bond or bonds, with good and sufficient scurity, for the payment thereof, with interest, to themselves, or their assigns, for the use of Dorchester county, and shall make return of such sale to the levy purt of the faid county at their next fitting, and deposit the said bonds with the derk of the county for safe keeping; provided, that the fee-simple of the said lots, or any of them, shall not be sold at a less price than at the rate of one hundred pounds for every fix pounds of ground-rent reserved upon such lot or lots.

IX. And be it enacted, That the said commissioners, or a majority of them, Who may exhand they are hereby authorised and empowered, upon their having taken bonds &c. s aforesaid with good and sufficient security for the purchase money of the feeimple of the said lot or lots, to execute releases or conveyances of the see-simthereof to the respective purchasers, and such bond or bonds shall be a lien upon the lot or lots on the sale of which they may be respectively taken.

X. And be it enasted, That the bond or bonds so to be taken by the said Bonds may be commissioners as aforesaid, may, under the direction of the levy court of Dor- assigned. hester county, be assigned in payment for the said lot intended as aforesaid to be purchased for the use of the said county, if the proprietor thereof, or person or whons authorised to sell the same, shall be willing to receive such bond or bonds payment; and the several commissioners aforesaid shall receive such compensaion for their trouble in the execution of the powers herein delegated to them as othe levy court shall seem reasonable.

XI. And be it enacted, That the justices of the said levy court shall be and Justices to pay bey are hereby authorifed and empowered to pay and discharge, not only the the purchase purchase money of the said lot, but also all expences attending the execution of the powers and discharge of the duties assigned or required by this act.

A ACT to authorise and empower the levy court of Montgomery Passed Januacounty to assess and levy a sum of money on the assessable property thereof for the purpose of building a new gaol in said county.

ME it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Samuel Turner, Commissionsenior, Charles Perry, John Beall Magruder, Benjamin Ray, senior, and ersappointed, Allen Bowie, shall be and are hereby appointed commissioners for the proofe of carrying this act into execution.
