HEREAS the cultivation of useful knowledge, and the advancement of the liberal arts and sciences, in any country, have a beneficial influence in promoting the interest and napplies whereas many liberal minded persons of Somerset county have contributed large for the nurchase of valuable books, and have formed themselves oms of money for the purchase of valuable books, and have formed themselves into a fociety, by the name of the Somerfet Library Company, and prayed that a law may pass creating them a body politic and corporate for ever; f herefore,

Preamble.

d II. Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the members Members inof the said society, heretofore voluntarily associated for promoting useful know-corporated, s lidge, and all others who shall hereafter become members of the said society, necording to the rules and regulations of said society, and who shall in all re-spects conform themselves to such laws, regulations and ordinances, as shall de hereafter be duly made and enacted by the said society, according to the tenor med, by the name and style of The Somerset Library Company, and by the some name they are hereby constituted a body corporate and politic, to have perpetual succession, and by the same name they, and their successors, are hereby declared and made able and capable in law to have, hold, receive and enjoy, lands tenements, rents, franchites, hereditaments, gifts and bequests, of what nature soever, in see-simple, or for term of life, lives, years or otherwise, and also to give, grant, let, sell, alien or assign, the same lands, tenements, hereditaallo to give, grant, let, sell, alien or assign, the same lands, tenements, hereditaments, goods, chattels and premises, according to the nature of the respective gifts, grants and bequests, made to them, the said company, and of their estate therein; provided that the amount of the clear yearly value of such real estate hes not exceed the value of two thousand dollars in any one year.
