VI. Jind be it i. . Acd, That if any person whatfoever, after the en the Land Market home a moretaid, that profume to fell, or cause to h any free inhabitant of the faid town, or any fervant or flave of tuch inhabitant, any article of provitions whatfoever which fuch person may be bringing or fending, or have brought or fent, to the faid town, or within one mile thereof, for sale, (except the articles herein before excepted,) either upon the stated marketdays aforefaid, or on any other days during the time of the market-hours herein before established, at any other place whatsoever but at or in the said markethouse, every such person thall forseit and pay the sum of fisteen shillings current money for every offence.

For flaughter- VII. And be it enacted, That if any person shall slaughter or butcher any kind of cattle, sheep or hogs, in or near the said market-house, or suffer the same to be done, every person so offending shall forseit and pay the sum of sisteen chillings current money for every such offence.

And for putting horses, &c. therein.

VIII. And be it enacted. That if any person, after the time herein before limitted, shall put, or cause to be put, any horse, mare or gelding, or any cart, waggen or other carriage, into or under the said market-house, on any pretence whatsoever, every such person shall forfeit and pay the sum of seven shillings and fix-pence current money for every fuch offence.

A clerk-to be appointed,

IX. And be it enacted. That the commissioners of the said town to be appointed by virtue of this act, shall, after the erection and receipt of the faid market-house as aforesaid, nominate and appoint a person of good repute and skill to be clerk of the said market; and if the person so appointed shall die; resign, or refuse to act, or be rendered incapable of acting by reason of missehaviour, or removal from office, the said commissioners shall assemble together as foon thereafter as conveniently may be, and nominate and appoint another qualified person to be clerk of the said market for the remainder of the year.

That every person to be appointed clerk of the said market as aforesaid, before he shall proceed to act as such, shall take an oath, or affirmation, before the faid commissioners, that he will diligently and faithfully, according to the best of his skill and judgment, execute and perform the several duties of clerk of the faid market, without favour, affection or partiality, and that he will not, directly or indirectly, demand or receive any fee or reward for performing such duties but what is or shall be allowed by law; and the said oath, or affirmation, shall be administered by the said commissioners, or any one of them.

His powers.

XI: And he it enacted, That the clerk of the said market shall have sufficient power and authority, at all times thereafter, to take care and charge of the faid market-house, and of the market thereof, and to examine and inspect provisions brought thereto for sale; to examine and try the weight of butter brought to the faid market, previously made up in prints or parcels, and if the fame shall not be found of the weight declared by the person offering the same for tale, to leize and fell the same, and the money arising from the sale thereof shall be paid to the commissioners, to be applied by them as is hereafter directed; and it any provision shall be found unfound or unwholesome; to seize and destroy the same; and alfor to try and adjust the scales, weights and measures, used at the laid markets, by the standards of the county, and if any weights or measures shall a falle or untrue, to spize the same, and on a just alteration thereof to dispose a the same to the highest bidder, and to account for the money arising from the sales with the said commissioners; and if any person shall think himself aggin by any feizure made by the clerk of faid market, he may appeal, within it days, to the commissioners of said town for redress, or any one of them. or they thall have power and authority to make fuch order therein as the deem just and proper.

XII. Sim be it enacted, That the faid market-house, and the stalls, illissues and appertenances thereof, shall be and the same are hereby vested
