III. And be it enaced. That the male members of the taid church, of the CHAR age of twenty-one years, may and shall meet on the first Monday of January at, or within ten days thereafter, and on the first Monday of January, or Members to thin ten days thereafter, in every year after the passing of this act, at their arch, or at such other place within the city of Baltimore as may be appointed the elders and trustees for the time being, notice thereof being given by the refident on the Sunday preceding the day of fuch meeting, and may and shall ben and there elect, by ballot, four of the most pious and discreet members of ne said church, to serve as elders for one year, and until another election is made in virtue of this act, as also to elect four other discreet members of their body as stees, to serve for one year, and until another election shall be made in virtue of this act.

- IV. And be it enasted, That the persons so elected as aforesaid elders and Persons to be trustees shall be, and they are hereby declared to be, the elders and trustees of elders, &c. the said church.
- V. And be it enacted, That in all cases where an elder or elders, trustee or Members to stustees, is or are to be appointed in virtue of this act, the president, elders and be nomistrustees for the time being, shall, at least eight days before the day of such election, nominate, from the most pious and discreet members of the said church, double the number of the elder or elders, trustee or trustees, so to be appointed.

VI. And be it enacted, That the president for the time being, and the elders President, &c. . and trustees now appointed, or their successors, who may hereafter be elected, or to meet, &c. a majority of them, may meet together from time to time, and as often as they hall judge necessary, to transact, manage and regulate, the business of the church, and to make such rules and by-laws as they may judge necessary for the good conduct and government of the members, and management of their temporal concerns; provided always, that fuch rules and by-laws be not contrary to the constitution and laws of this state.

VII. And be it enacted, That the said body corporate shall not be able or Not to purcapable of purchasing any property, real or personal, unless with the consent and ty, &c. approbation of three fourths of their whole number.

VIII. And be it enaced, That all the lands and tenements, with their ap-Lands, &c. pertenances, now vested in the minister, or any other person for the use of the aid church, and all other property of the said church, shall be and are hereby absolutely and unconditionally vested in the said body corporate, and their sucessors, for ever; and the said corporation, with the consent and approbation of aree fourths of their whole number, shall be, and are hereby declared to be, the and capable of bargaining and felling, leafing and conveying, any part of the said property, or any other property that may hereaster be acquired by the aid corporation, in as full and effectual a manner as any person or body politic may or can do.

IX. And be it enaues. That at all meetings of the said elders and trustees Minister to be e minister for the time being shall be the president; and all acts or deeds of the president, &c. rporation shall be signed by the president, and sealed with the corporate seal; d all deeds for the conveyance of any land of the corporation, which by the w of the land ought to be acknowledged and recorded, shall be signed and aled as aforesaid, and also acknowledged by the president, in behalf of the corration, in the same manner and form as is prescribed in the case of individual ntors; and all acts and deeds of the said corporation, so authenticated, shall valid and effectual in law.

. And he it enauted, That in case of the absonce, removal or death, of the Isabsent, another, the elders and trustees for the time being may appoint one of their own other to be y president pro tempore, who, during such absence, or in the case of removal
