Directories to

XXXII. And us it enacted. That the said president and directors shall cause to be erected directories at proper and convenient situations, to note to all conductors or drivers of carriages on the turnpike roads aforesaid, that they shall at all times pass on the lest of each other, under the penalty of three dollars for every offence, to be recovered and applied as aforesaid.

Rights, &c. in certain cases, may be resumed.

XXXIII. And he it enalted, That if the said company shall not proceed to carry on said work within three years after the passing of this act, and some not within twenty years thereafter complete the said roads, according to the transintent and meaning of this act, then, in either of these cases, it shall and may be lawful for this state to resume all and singular the rights, liberties and evid vileges, hereby granted to the company.

C H A P. LXXI.

Passed January 20.

An ACT to make a temporary allowance to the chancellor, in addition to his falary as chancellor and judge of the land-office.

Additional allowance.

of this state for the time being, as chancellor and judge of the land-office, shall be entitled to receive four hundred and fixty-ix deliars and fixty-feven cents, in addition to the permanent salary fixed by law.

When to be paid.

II. And be it enacted, That the faid sum shall be paid at the same time, and in the same manner, during the continuance of this act, as his permanent slary is by law directed to be paid.

Duration.

III. This act to continue and be in force till the twentieth day of Ogcor, eighteen hundred, and until the end of the next session of assembly that seal happen thereaster.

C H A P. LXXII.

Passed January 20.

A Further supplement to an act to streighten and amend the public roads in Harford county, and for other purposes.

Preamble.

HEREAS Abraham Jarrett and Hannah Crosmore have set forth by their petition to this general assembly, that they are much aggriced by the road leading from the Upper Cross Roads to Benjamin Amoss's mill, in said county, as laid out by the commissioners appointed under the act to which this is a further supplement, and praying a power may be vested in the levy court of said county to appoint commissioners to review the said road; therefore,

Orrit to apprint perions, &c. of Harford county be and they are hereby empowered and directed to appoint, by warrant, five persons, freeholders and residents in said county, to review the above described road, which said persons, so appointed as aforesaid, shall and they are hereby cirected and required, as soon as conveniently may be thereaster, to meet, examine and review, the above described road, as said out, marked and bounded as aforesaid, and if, upon such review, they, in their judgment, shall be of opinion that the above described road, laid out as aforesaid, ought to be altered, then they are hereby required to alter, lay out, survey, mark and bound the road aforesaid so altered, and make return thereof agreeably to the direction and regulations of the original act to which this is a surther supplement; and the said court, if they shall approve the same, thereupon shall direct the said road, so altered and laid out, to be cleared and amended in the same manner as its directed by the said original act.

Who shall take an oath,

of this act shall, before they proceed to exercise the powers hereby given, the oath prescribed by the said original act, and shall have the same allowand the commissioners appointed under the act asoresaid for their actual services.
