Est enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the orphans When courts courts in Dorchester county shall bereafter be hald on the I in June, August, October, December, February and April, yearly, or oftener, if need be, by adjournment.

II. And be it enacted, That the third section of the act passed at February Part of an act session, one thousand seven hundred and eighty-six, entitled, An act to revive and repealed. continue the proceedings of the orphans court of Dorchester county, be and the fame is hereby repealed.

An ACT to empower the vestry of Shrewsbury parish, in Kent Passed Januacounty, to fell the glebe-land belonging to the same.

THEREAS the vestry of Shrewsbury parish, of Kent county, have Preamble. petitioned this general affembly for a law empowering them to fell the glebe-land belonging to faid parish, for the purpose of purchasing other land in a more convenient and advantageous fituation, and also to enable said vestry to repair the church and chapel in said parish, which are in a ruinous condition; and have represented to this general affembly, that the said vestry puffels no funds to defray the expence of repairing faid church and chapel; there-

H. Be it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the westry of Vestry may faid parith be and they are hereby empowered to fell said glebe-land, and to apply such part of the money arising from the sale thereof as they deem proper to the purchase of other land for the use of said parish, and the surplus to the reparation of faid church and chapel; provided nevertheless, that the said vestry give three months previous notice, by advertisements stuck up at the courthouse door for said county, and one at each door of the church and chaper respectively, of the time and place of sale.

C H A P. LXXIX.

An ACT to make a temporary allowance to the judges of the Passed Januacourt of appeals, in addition to their permanent salaries.

E it enacted, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That each of the judges Additional of the court of appeals shall be entitled to receive three hundred dollars, J in addition to their permanent salaries fixed by law.

II. And be it enacted, "That the said sums shall be paid at the same time, and When to be in the same manner, during the continuance of this act, as their permanent salaries are by law directed to be paid.

III. This act to continue and be in force until the twentieth day of October, Duration. eighteen hundred, and until the end of the next session of assembly that shall happen thereafter.
