> C H A P. XXIII.

An ACT for the relief of Philemon Dorsey, of Anne-Arundel county, a lunatic. Passed Jan. 15. WHEREAS it is represented to this general assembly, that the annual proceeds of the Preamble, personal estate of the said Philemon Dorsey is by no means sufficient for his support, and that he is feized in fee of two parcels of land, fituate in Anne-Arundel county, which are totally approductive, the one not being improved, and the other subject to the life estate of his mother, and that if the same, or part thereof, were sold on a credit, and the proceeds loaned out on pterest, for the use of the said lunatic, that the same would be amply sufficient for his support and maintenance; and it appearing reasonable the real estate of the said lunatic should be applied vius 10 his support,

II. BE IT ENACTED, by the General Affembly of Maryland, That the chancellar for the time being Chancellor to have power and authority, upon application of any person on the part of said Philemon Dorsey, and being fatisfied that it is necessary for the support and maintenance of faid Philemon Dorsey, to order the whole, or such part of the real estate of said Philemon Dorsey as he may mink necessary, to be fold for the purpose aforefuld, upon such terms as he may think proper, and to appoint a truftee or truftees for the purpose of effecting such fale or sales.

III. And BE IT ENACTED, That all sales made by the authority of the chancellor under this To be confirmfor all, shall be notified to, and confirmed by, the chancellor, before any conveyance of the property ed by him, &c. hall be made; and bond, with good and fufficient security, to be approved by the chancellor, said be given by the person or persons empowered to sell the property as aforesaid, for the due accution of the trust committed, which bond shall be lodged with the register in chancery.

IV. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the chancellor shall have full power and authority to direct He may direct the application of money arising from such sale or sales, and the interest thereof, for the purposes the application aforefaid, and to direct from time to time in what funds the money arising from faid fales shall evested, and in all things to order in the premises as he may deem for the benefit and advantage of faid lunatic.

V. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the principal fum arifing from the fale of the faid real effate, To whom it or fo much thereof as may remain unapplied to the use and maintenance of said lunatic, during shall belong. the life-time of faid lunatic, shall, on the death of the faid lunatic, belong to such person or persons, his, her or their heirs, or legal representatives, as would have been entitled to the al faid real estate in case the same had not been sold.

C H A P. XXIV.

An ACT for the establishment of vestries for each parish in this state. HEREAS it is represented to this general assembly, that the act for the establishment of Preamble. felect vestries, and the supplements thereto, are inadequate to the exigencies of the prowhat episcopal church in this state, for which the said acts were intended to provide,

II. BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That vestries shall be chosen for each How vestries within this state in the following manner: Every free white male citizen of this state are to be wove twenty-one years of age, resident of the parish where he offers to vote six months next preceding the day of election, who shall have been entered on the books of the faid parish one month at least preceding the day of election as a member of the protestant episcopal church, and ho shall also contribute to the charges of the said parish in which he offers to vote such sum as ajority of the vestry in each parish shall annually, within ten days after their election, in ting, make known and declare, not exceeding two dollars, shall have a right of suffrage in election of vestrymen for such parish; and all persons so qualified shall, on the next ensuing Monday, assemble in their respective parishes, at their parish church, or if there shall be or more protestant episcopal churches in any parish, at the church sirst built therein, or if e be in any parish no such church, then at such other place as the rector of the parish, or if be no rector, as any three or more vestrymen, may have publicly notified to the parishioners, the faid persons, so qualified to vote, when assembled, or such of them as may affemble in parish, shall proceed, by a majority of votes, to elect, by ballot, eight vestrymen from ig the persons qualified to vote, who, with the rector of the parish for the time being, shall seemed and confidered the veftry of the faid parish for the ensuing year, and the rector of parish shall always be one of the vestry.
