and transfer, to the use of my creditors, all my property, real, personal or mixed, (the necesfary wearing apparel of mytelf and family, as allowed by my truttee, only excepted,) that I have or claim any title to, or interest in, at this time, and all debts, rights and claims, which have at this time, or that I am in any respect entitled to, in possession, remainder or reverafion; and that I have not, directly or indirectly, at any time before, fold, conveyed, leafed, a disposed of, or intrusted or conceased, any part of my property of any kind, or any part of my debts, rights or claims, thereby wilfully to defraud or deceive my creditors, or any of "them, or to fecure the same, or to receive or expect any profit, benefit or advantage thereby;" and shall execute and acknowledge, before two justices of the same county, a deed to his trustee, appointed in virtue of this act, on behalf of his creditors, for all his property, debts, rights and laims, agreeably to his faid oath, in trust for his creditors, a schedule whereof he shall infert in, or annex to, the faid deed, that thereupon, and for ever thereafter, the faid Philip Edwards hall, by virtue of this act, be acquitted, released, and for ever discharged, from all debts, promiles, contracts, agreements and covenants, due from, or contracted, made or entered into, by him, before the passing this act; provided, that any property acquired by the faid Philip Edwards, fifter the making the faid deed, by descent, or in his own right by devise, bequest, or in course of distribution, shall be liable for the payment of his debts.

III. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the sheriff of Baltimore county shall be and is hereby ap- Sheriff appointed as truftee in behalf of the creditors of the faid Philip Edwards; and the faid theriff, be-pointed truftee, fore he acts as fuch, thall take the following oath before some justice of the peace of said county, to wit: " I, A. B. do swear, that I will faithfully, impartially and honestly, according to the "best of my skill and knowledge, execute the feveral powers and trusts reposed in me as trustee a for the creditors of Philip Edwards, without favour, affection, prejudice or malice."

IV. AND BE IT ENACTED, That if the faid Philip Edwards shall be arrested or imprisoned on If arrested, to any process sucd out on any judgment or decree obtained against him for any debt, damages or be discharged, colts, contracted, owing, or growing due before the passing of this act, the court out of which such process iffued shall and may discharge the said Philip Edwards on motion; and if the said Philip Edwards shall be arrested or imprisoned on any process for the recovery of any debt, damages or costs, contracted, owing, or growing due before the passing of this act, the court before whom fuch process shall be returned shall and may discharge the said Philip Edwards out of custody on his common appearance being entered, without any special bail; provided, that the discharge of the faid Philip Edwards shall not acquit any other person from such debt, damages or costs, or any part thereof, but that all fuch perions thall be answerable for the same in such manner as any part thereof, but that all fuch pether they were before the passing of this act.

V. AND BE IT ENACTED, That if any creditor of the faid Philip Edwards shall, at any time When fraud is within two years after he is discharged, allege in writing to the justices of Baltimore county alleged he may be examined, court, in court fitting, that he the faid Philip Edwards hath, directly or indirectly, fold, conveyed, &c. lafed, or otherwife difpofed of, or intrufted or concealed, any part of his property of any kind, or any part of his debts, rights or claims, thereby wilfully to deceive or defraud his creditors, he or any of them, or to fecure the fame, or to receive or expect any profit, benefit or advantage thereby, the faid court may thereupon examine the faid Philip Edwards on interrogatories, on outh, for the discovery of his property, or any concealment thereof, and respecting his conduct touching the same, or the said justices may, in their ancretion, affect an including the said court, to determine the truth of any allegation made by the said Philip Edwards; and if the said Philip Edwards shall be sound guilty of any wilful fraud or deceit of his creditors, he having any benesit of this act; and in case the said Philip Edwards shall, at any time within two years as aforesaid, upon any indictment, be convict of wilfully, falfely and corruptly swearing to any matter or thing in his oath aforesaid contained, he shall suffer as in case of wilful and corrupt perjury, and likewise be liable to his creditors, and be wholly deprived of any relief or benefit by this act.

of A Further additional supplement to an act, entitled, An act to streighten and Passed Jan. 15, amend the several public roads in several counties, and for other purposes.

HEREAS under the act of feventeen hundred and ninety, to which this is a further ad- Preamble. ditional supplement, some omissions have been made in the returns and adoption of the following roads in Montgomery county, to wit: One leading from George-town to Montgomery court-house, and from Montgomery court-house by Benjamin Edward's to the mouth of Monocacy, and one other road from Monegomery court in the state of and one other road from Montgomery court-house by Middle Brook mills to Frederick county

II. BE IT ENACTED, by the General Affembly of Maryland, That the above described roads, as Roads confirme adopted, or intended to have been adopted, by the county court of faid county, be and the fame ed. are hereby confirmed, agreeable to the adoption of faid court, as fully and completely as though the same had been done agreeable to the directions of the act aforesaid.

in a III. And BE IT ENACTED, That Thomas Howard, Thomas Maccubbin and Benjamin Ray, Commissioners ienior, be and they are hereby appointed commissioners for the purposes herein after mentioned, appointed, &c. they, or any two of them, may and are hereby empowered to appoint a surveyor to survey I fuch parts of the aforefaid roads which have not heretofore been furveyed, and the plots and ourles of the same returned and recorded agreeable to the act to which this is a further addional supplement, and in case of death, resignation, disqualishcation, or resusal to act of any of the commissioners aforefaid, when such vacancy or vacancies shall happen during the sitting of levy court, the faid court may make other appointments to fill fuch vacancy or vacancies, and fuch vacancy or vacancies shall happen during the recess of the court, then and in that case the fenior justice of the peace for the county, with two other justices, shall and are hereby vested
