with power to make fuch is appointments, and fuch re-appointments shall be made from a time, as often as occasion may require, until each and every of the faid roads, or fuch pa thereof as are necessary, shall be surveyed, plotted, the courses returned and recorded; and, faid commissioners, or any two of them, are hereby directed to survey, mark and bound the ro aforefaid, and make return of the plots and couries agreeable to the adoption, or intend adoption, of the county court aforefaid, to the clerk of the county, to be by him recorded; a the supervisor for the time being be and he is hereby required, under the direction of the leve court, to open all fuch parts of the aforefaid roads, (as are not now opened,) the width of fixe feet, and the faid roads, when so opened, shall be taken for, and they are hereby doclared, public roads, and may be repaired as other public roads in laid county.

Their allowance, &c.

IV. And BE IT ENACTED, That the commissioners and surveyor appointed by and in puris ance of this act, shall be allowed, for each day they shall be necessarily employed on or concern. ing faid roads, a fum to be afcertained by the levy court, not exceeding two dollars and fixty. feven cents.

Preamble.

An ACT for the establishment of a school in Caroline county. THEREAS the happiness and prosperity of every community depend much on the proper education of youth, and it being the interest and duty of this state to assist with legislative countenance every attempt to diffeminate and promote the growth of useful knowledge, and it also appearing that a considerable sum of money has been subscribed and already expended in the erection and endowment of a school in the county aforesaid, which, if countenanced by the le

giflature, may probably become an ufeful institution; therefore,

II. BE IT ENACTED, by the General Affembly of Maryland, That there be erected, and hereby is A school eresterected and established, in Caroline county aforefaid, a school for the education of youth in the ed, &c. learned and foreign languages, the useful arts, sciences and literature, the style, name and title of which faid school, and the constitution thereof, shall be, and are hereby declared to be, as is herein after mentioned and defined.

To be under the direction of truffees, &c.

III, AND BE IT ENACTED. That the faid school shall be under the direction and management of Francis Sellers, William Smith, Samuel Barrow, Henry Downes, Henry Nichols, the third, William Richardson and George Martin, trustees, which said trustees, and their successors, to be elected as herein after mentioned, shall for ever hereafter be, and they are hereby erected, establithed and declared to be, one body politic and corporate, with perpetual fuccession, in deed and in law, to all intents and purposes whatsoever, by the name, style and title, of The Trustees of Hillsborough School, in Caroline county, by which name and title the faid trustees, and their fucceffors, shall be competent and capable at law and in equity to take to themselves, and their fuccessors, for the faid school, any estate in lands, tenements, hereditaments, goods, chattels, monies or other effects, by the gift, grant, bargain, fale or bequest, of any perion or persons whatfoever, provided the fame do not exceed in the whole the yearly value of two thousand dollars, and the faid lands, tenements, hereditaments, goods, chatters, monies and other effects, to grant, bargain, fell, demife, and place out on interest, or otherwise dispose of, for the use of faid school, in such manner as to them, or at least a majority of them, shall seem most beneficial to the inflitution, and to receive the rents, profits and issues arising therefrom, and to apply the fame to the proper use and support of said school, and by the same name to sue and be sued, commence, profecute and defend, implead and be impleaded, in any court of law or equity, and in all manner of fuits and actions whatfoever, and generally, by and in the fame name, to do and transact all and every the business concerning the premises, or which shall be incidentally necesfary thereto, as fully and effectually as any natural person or body politic or corporate within this state have power to manage their own concerns.

Who shall cause a feal to be made, &c.

IV. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the trustees of the faid school shall cause to be made for their use one common seal, with such devices and inscriptions thereon as to them shall seem proper, under which all acts relating to faid corporation shall be authenticated, and such seal at their pleasure to break and device anew.

And choose a prefident, &c.

V. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the faid Francis Sellers, William Smith, Samuel Barrow, Henry Downes, Henry Nichols, the third, William Richardson and George Martin, trustees, and their fuccessors, or a majority of them, shall, on their first meeting, and at all times there after when necessary, choose, from among their number, a president, who, with the rest of the faid trustees, shall be equal and competent to the transaction of all business relative to the said institution, and they shall meet at such times and places in Caroline county as to them shall feem expedient, for the purposes of regulating the concerns of said school, but no transaction shall be valid unless the same shall be made at an adjourned meeting, or unless the president of the said trustees, or in case of his death the first named on the list, shall have called them together by advertisement set up at the school-house door three weeks antecedent to the time of such meeting.

Prefident shall

VI. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the president of the said trustees shall in no case whatever not have a vote, have a vote, except it shall be to decide a question or election where the said trustees shall be equally divided in opinion.

How vacancies are to be filled.

VII. AND BE IT ENACTED, That in case of a vacancy happening among the said trustees death, refignation, or removal from the county, the faid trustees shall, as foon thereafter as the feem proper, proceed to fill up fuch vacancy, and the person having the greatest number of votes among the trustees assembled for the purpose shall be declared to be duly elected.

Configution to renges &c.

VIII. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the conflitution of faid school as herein and hereby en blished and declared, shall be and remain for ever the inviolable constitution of said school, and
