justices, or a majority of them, may adjourn from day to day until the faid roads shall be duly. sicertained, and overfeers appointed as aforefaid.

III. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the clerk of the court of faid county shall attend the justices Clerk to attend of the peace at their faid meetings, and shall make fair entries and records of their proceed- the justices, &c. ings in virtue of this act, and shall, within the space of ten days after the appointment of overfeers as aforefaid, iffue warrants to the faid overfeers, under his hand, and the feal of his office, notifying the faid perfors of their appointments respectively as overseers of the faid roads, and the faid clerk thall, within the time aforefaid, deliver the faid warrants to the flieriss of Somerlet county aforefaid, and shall take the receipt of the sheriss for the same; and the said theriff thall be and he is hereby authorifed and required, within the space of twenty days after receiving the faid warrants, to deliver the fame to the respective persons appointed overseers as aforefaid, and to take their feveral receipts for the fame; and if any of the faid overfeers full refuse to receive their respective warrants, the said sheriff shall leave the same at their respective places of abode, and certify the justices of the peace thereof; and if the clerk or sheriff of the faid county shall neglect or refuse to execute and perform the respective duties herein before required, within the respective periods limitted as aforefaid, the faid clerk or sheriff, so neglecting or refusing, shall forfeit and pay a sum not exceeding thirty dollars for each offence.

IV. AND BE IT ENACTED, That each and every person so appointed overseer as aforefaid, Penalty on owho shall neglect or refuse to accept of his appointment, after receiving his warrant as aforesaid, verteers for reshall forfeit and pay a sum not exceeding ten dollars; provided nevertheless, that no member of the legislature, magistrate, clergyman, ichoolmaster, practising attorney, coroner, sherist, deputy-theriff, constable, physician, or commissioner of the tax, shall be liable to ferve as overseers of the faid roads, without his or their confent; and provided also, that no person shall be compellable to act as overfeer of any road more than one year in every three years, without his confent.

V. AND BE IT ENACTED, That it shall be the duty of the faid overseers to keep all the public Overseers to roads in the faid county well and fufficiently cleared and grubbed, fit for travelling, twenty feet wide at the least, and to make and keep good and substantial bridges over all the heads of rivers, creeks, branches and fwamps, where the same shall be necessary, for the convenient and easy passage of travellers, with their waggons, carts, carriages, horses and cattle, and to remove all nuifances which may obstruct or annoy their passage, and well and sufficiently to causeway all and fingular fuch places in and upon the faid roads as shall require the same.

VI. PROVIDED ALWAYS, That nothing in this act shall be considered to make it the duty of Proviso. overleers of the roads aforefaid to make or repair any bridge or bridges above fifteen feet in length, but they shall continue to be built and repaired in the same manner as at prefent.

VII. AND BE IT ENACTED, That if any of the faid overfeers shall not well and sufficiently Penalty for new tlear, grub, amend and repair, the faid feveral and respective roads committed to their charge, within a reasonable time after the same shall be out of repair, or shall not make and keep in repair good and fubitantial bridges over the heads of rivers, creeks, branches or fwamps, where the fame shall be necessary as aforesaid, or shall not remove all nuisances from the said roads, or shall not well and fufficiently caufeway all and fingular tuch places in and upon the faid roads as shall require the same, or shall permit or suffer any fallen trees, or other obstruction, to remain in or across any of the said public roads for the space of two days after notice thereof, or shall neglect to fell, or cause to be felled and removed, all decayed or dead trees on either side of the said public roads, whose limbs or any of them hang over the same, and may by their falling injure travellers, or shall not lop and cut off all limbs or branches of trees hanging or projecting over the faid roads, within fifteen feet above the furface thereof, or shall in any other manner fail or neglect to perform the duties of an overfeer of the faid roads, according to the directions of this act, every fuch overfeer, fo failing or neglecting, shall forfeit and pay a sum not exceeding five dollars for every offence, except in the time of wheat harvest.

VIII. AND BE IT ENACTED, That it shall and may be lawful for the several and respective They may dig. overfeers of the said roads, and they are hereby authorised and empowered, as often as need shall require, to dig, take and remove, any stones, gravel or earth, which may be found on any stones, &c. land adjoining the roads for which the same may be necessary, and to employ the same in the repairing of the faid roads; and for the making or repairing of bridges over the heads of rivers, creeks, branches, fwamps, or other low and miry places, through and over which the faid roads may pass, to cut down, or cause to be cut down, any tree or trees growing on any of the head adjacent lands to such places where bridges of causeways may be necessary as aforesaid, and the adjacent lands to such places where bridges of such lands, and to apply the same to the making fame trees to maul and carry away from off fuch lands, and to apply the fame to the making or repairing of the faid bridges or causeways; provided always, that no enclosures shall be laid open or entered into to obtain the several materials aforefaid, or any of them, without the confent of the owner or owners thereof.

IX. AND BE IT ENACTED, That due compensation be made or secured to him or them by the Compensation * i county for the feveral materials aforefaid, according to the full value thereof, in fuch manner as to be made, &c. the justices of the levy court shall direct and appoint.

X. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the faid overfeers shall have power, and they are hereby Overseers may thorifod and required, to call for all and fingular the able bodied free male inhabitants of their call on all free spective limits, above the age of twenty-one years and under the age of fifty years, and upon tants, &co I and fingular the able bodied male fervants and flaves refiding therein above the age of fixteen ears and under the age of fifty years, to labour and affift in clearing, amending, improving and repairing, the leveral and respective roads aforefaid, and to require such and so many of the faid perions
