perfons as they shall from time to time deem necessary, to assemble at such place within the respective limits as the faid overseers shall severally appoint, with sufficient implements, and thereupon to proceed in the execution of fuch work upon the faid roads, for the improve ment and repair thereof, as the respective overseers shall order and direct; and the said over feers shall also have power to hire and employ carts and teams for the carrying and removing all fuch flones, dirt, gravel and timber, as may be deemed requifite for repairing and completing the faid roads and bridges, and the expence of fuch carts and teams thall be levied upon the county.

Take a lift of mames, &c.

XI. And BE IT ENACTED, That within one month after the receipt of their respective war. rants, the feveral overfeers aforefaid, under the direction of the faid juffices, shall take down a proper lift of the names of all and fingular the able bodied free male inhabitants refiding therein, above the age of twenty-one years and under the age of fifty years, and of all the able bodied male fervants and flaves above the age of fixteen years and under the age of fifty years; and the faid overfeers thall juftly and impartially call for and require the labour of all and fingular the persons aforesaid, alternately, and in such convenient numbers and classes as to place the burthen of their service equally upon all; provided nevertheless, that the labour of the said persons shall not be called forth for the purposes of this act during the season of wheat harvest, nor in fuch manner as to take more than half the number of persons aforesaid belonging to one family at the fame time:

Summon the

XII. AND BE IT ENACTED, That as often as the faid overfeers shall judge it necessary to call upon the faid inhabitants for their labour in and upon the faid roads, they shall summon, or cause to be summoned, the number and class which they shall have previously arranged, having had class arranged, upon the faid inhabitants for their labour in and upon the faid roads, they shall summon, or cause regard to the quantity and quality of work necessary to be done upon the said roads, giving each free person liable to work upon the same, and the master, mistress or overseer of each servant or flave aforesaid, two days notice at the least of the time and place appointed for their labour, except in fuch extraordinary cases as may require a shorter notice, and every free person liable to work upon the roads fo summoned shall be obliged to attend in person, or to provide a sufficient substitute; and if any person, being so summoned, shall neglect or resuse to attend, or to provide a sufficient substitute, he shall forseit and pay the sum of one dollar for each offence; and if any person shall attend, and not persorm the reasonable labour required of him by the overfeer of the road, according to his ability, he shall be adjudged a defaulter, and shall incur the same penalty as if he had neglected to attend; and in case the master, mistress or overseer, of any fervant or flave, upon being notified as aforefaid, shall refuse or neglect to fend such fervant or flave, or if fuch fervant or flave, after being fent, shall neglect to perform his reasonable labour as aforefaid, fuch mafter, mistress or overfeer, shall forfeit and pay the sum of one dollar for every fervant or flave fo refused or neglected to be ient, or when fent refusing to work as aforefaid.

And keep a lift of all defaulters, &c.

XIII. AND BE IT ENACTED, That it shall be the duty of the said overseers to keep a true and proper lift of all and every person or defaulter, who, being summoned as aforesaid, shall negled or refuse to attend at the times and places appointed as aforefaid, or if attending, shall not perform his reasonable labour, and of every matter, miltress er overseer of servants and slaves, who shall incur the penalty aforefaid; and the faid overfeers of roads shall, once in every fix months, call upon each and every of the faid persons liable to a fine or fines, and demand the payment of all and fingular the fums of money by them so forfeited, and on refusal or neglect to pay the same, the said overseers shall proceed to recover the same before a single magistrate, by due course of law; and the faid overseers shall annually render their respective accounts of all fines and forfeitures received by them respectively in virtue of this act to the justices of the levy court, upon oath, or affirmation, and pay the amount thereof in such manner as the said justices shall order and appoint.

How vacancies

XIV. AND BE IT ENACTED, That if any of the overfeers fo to be appointed shall refuse to act, are to be filled. remove, become difqualified, or die, it shall and may be lawful for any two of the neighbouring justices of the peace to supply every vacancy so happening, by the appointment of another person, and they shall certify every such appointment, under their hands, to the clerk of the county, who shall record the same, and within ten days thereafter shall issue a warrant to the person so appointed, and deliver the same to the sheriff, to be served upon the party as herein

Overleer's allowance.

XV. AND BE IT ENACTED, That every overfeer to to be appointed by virtue of this act shall respectively be allowed a sum, not exceeding ten dollars by the year, for the performance of the several duties required of them by this act, which allowance shall be paid to them by the justices of the levy court out of the sines and forfeitures imposed and levied by this act, and if found to be insufficient for this purpose at the expiration of every year, the deficiency shall be affested and levied upon the county in the same manner as other public charges.

Justice may 1f-

XVI. AND BE IT ENACTED, That any of the justices of the peace of the faid county, who, fue his warrant upon his own view, or on the information, oath or affirmation, of one or more credible witnesses in certain cases, shall discover or be satisfied that any bridge, road or causeway, is out of repair, from the neglective of duty of the overfeer within whose limits the same shall be, except in time of wheat harve shall be authorised to issue his warrant, in the name of the state, against such overseer, direct ed to the constable of the hundred, and returnable before himself, or some other justice of in peace, who shall proceed to give judgment according to the merits of the case, and if judgment shall be rendered against him for the fine or forfeiture imposed by this act, and if he shall is pay the same, the said justice of the peace may thereupon issue process of execution for the covery thereof, and the same shall be accounted for and paid to the order of the levy con provided nevertheless, that nothing herein contained shall prevent any of the said eversees
