C H A P.

An ACT to open and establish a road from Worton neck to Chester-town, in Passed Jan. 15. Kent county.

WHEREAS it is represented to this general assembly, by the petition of fundry inhabitants Preamble of Worton neck, in Kent county, that they experience appear in the fundry inhabitants are preamble. of Worton neck, in Kent county, that they experience great inconvenience for want of a direct road leading from faid neck to Chefter-town, as also a convenient communication with the goads leading to the mills and places of worship in their neighbourhood;

H. BE IT ENACTED, by the General Affembly of Maryland, That Benjamin Chambers, James An- Commissioners Icrion, junior, and Thomas Wilkins, forest, be and they are hereby appointed commissioners for appointed, &c. the purpose, and any two of them are hereby authorised and empowered to lay out and open, at the expence of Kent county, a road, not exceeding twenty-five feet wide, beginning for the fame at lot number one of the purchase upon sales of the land of Richard Lloyd, deceased, and runging thence up the neck through the aforesaid land to the corner of John Rickets's lot, then with his land until it interfects the main road leading from John Bordley's farm in Worton neck aforefaid to Chester-town; and the said road, when so laid out and completed, shall be recorded among the records of faid county, and be thereafter deemed and taken to be a public road, and hall be kept in repair as other public roads in faid county are directed to be kept.

III. And BE IT ENACTED, That the commissioners aforesaid shall and they are hereby directed Freeholders to to apply to any justice of the peace for the county aforesaid, who shall issue his warrant, under be summoned, hand and feal, directed to any constable of the said county, commanding him to summon twelve freeholders, difinterested as to the lands, and not connected with any person through whose lands the faid road may pass, to appear at a place and on a day by him to be appointed, and after taking the following oath, or affirmation, as the case may be, to wit: "I, A. B. do swear, or "folemnly, fincerely and truly declare and affirm, that I will honeftly and faithfully estimate and value the damage and injury fustained by C. D. by opening a road through the land of the faid "C. D. in pursuance of the directions of this act," shall proceed to ascertain and value what damages may be fustained by any person or persons through whose land the said road may pass, by opening and clearing the same, and shall return the damages by them assessed to the clerk of the faid county, and the damages so affessed shall be conclusive; and after the valuation so made, the faid commissioners shall proceed to open and clear the same, provided that the said road shall not pass through any houses, gardens, orchards or meadows, unless with the consent of the owner thereof.

AND BE IT ENACTED, That the clerk of the faid county, at their next levy court follow- Damages to be ing, shall lay the damages so affested before the said court, and the justices of the faid court shall laid before the by upon the affestable property of the faid county the damages to adjudged to be fustained by court, &c. the persons through whose lands the road as aforesaid shall pass, and which sum, when collected, hall be paid to the person or persons sustaining such damages by the collector of the said county.

. C H A P, XLI.

An ACT to authorise the building a market-house on the county wharf in Passed Jan. 15. Chester-town, in Kent county, and for the regulation of the said market.

WHEREAS it has been represented to this general allembly, by the memorial of fundry in-Preamble. habitants of Chefter-town, in Kent county, that the market-house at present in said town stoo small for the accommodation of the inhabitants thereof, and is situated at such a distance from the water as to make it inconvenient to many persons to attend the same, and they have yed for the liberty of erecting another market-house on the county wharf in the said town, at their own expence, and to establish the same as a market, when it shall be completely finished; and the same appearing reasonable to this general assembly, therefore,

II. BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Richard Tilghman, the fourth, Commissioners William McKenny and Robert Anderson, be and they are hereby appointed commissioners for appointed, &co. e purposes in this act mentioned; and the said commissioners, or any two of them, are hereby horifed to receive, by subscription or otherwise, such sum or sums of money as they may nk necessary for the purpose of building a market-house on the public ground adjoining the nty wharf in Chester-town, in Kent county, and the said commissioners, or any two of them, and they are hereby empowered, as foon as a fufficient fum of money shall be subscribed, and " part thereof collected as they may think necessary, to contract and agree with any person persons they may think proper to erect and build a market-house on some part of the public and adjoining the county wharf in Chefter-town, in Kent county, to be fixed and agreed on the faid commissioners, or any two of them, sufficiently large for the accommodation of the habitants of the faid town.

II. AND BE IT ENACTED, That as foon as the faid market-house shall be finished, all and Provisions to Har the provisions mentioned in the act. entitled, An act to establish a market at the market. he extended, in Choster-town, in Kent county, and for the regulation of the said market, and the difat supplements passed thereto, shall be and the same are hereby extended to the marketto be built and established by virtue of this act, so far as the same shall not be inconsistent any of the provisions herein contained.
